INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Matador E717 set is designed for intuitive assembly using the provided hammer and pliers. Follow these general steps for construction:

- 1. **Select Components:** Choose the appropriate wooden blocks and rods for your desired model. Refer to the idea booklet for guidance or create your own designs.
- 2. **Connect Pieces:** Insert a rod into the hole of a wooden block. Use the wooden hammer to gently tap the rod into place, securing the connection. Ensure connections are firm but avoid excessive force.
- 3. **Build Structures:** Continue connecting blocks and rods to form your desired structure. The precision-drilled holes allow for stable and intricate constructions.
- 4. **Disassembly:** To separate pieces, use the provided pliers to grip the rod and gently pull it out. For stubborn connections, a light tap with the hammer on the block near the rod might help loosen it, followed by using the pliers.



MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Difficulty Disconnecting Pieces:** Use the pliers as instructed. If a rod is stuck, try wiggling it gently while pulling with the pliers. Avoid twisting excessively, which could damage the wood or rod.
- Loose Connections: If a connection feels loose, ensure the rod is fully inserted. Over time, some wear might occur; however, the design generally provides stable connections.
