# RYOBI RY18PCA-0 ONE+ Patio Cleaner User Manual

## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Ryobi RY18PCA-0 18V ONE+ Patio Cleaner with wire brush is designed for efficient removal of moss and weeds from patio surfaces. This tool simplifies the cleaning process by utilizing a high-speed wire brush to clear gaps and joints in your patio. Its ergonomic design includes a telescopic shaft and an adjustable auxiliary handle, ensuring comfortable use for various user heights. A protective guard is integrated to shield the user from debris during operation. The wire brush can be interchanged with the RAC818 nylon brush (sold separately) for cleaning more delicate surfaces. Please note that the RY18PCA-0 is sold as a 'bare' tool, meaning the battery and charger are not included, but it is fully compatible with all batteries and chargers within the 18V ONE+ system.

- Removes manual effort of clearing weeds, moss, and grass from pathways and patios.
- Wire wheel spins at 1350rpm for effortless weed removal.
- Eliminates the need for arduous scraping, burning, or spraying of weeds.
- Telescoping pole allows height adjustment for user comfort, reducing bending or stooping.
- Provides over an hour of runtime with a RYOBI 18V ONE+ 4.0Ah Battery RB1840X.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always read and understand all safety warnings, instructions, illustrations, and specifications provided with this power tool. Failure to follow all instructions listed below may result in electric shock, fire, and/or serious injury.

## General Safety Warnings:

- **Work Area Safety:** Keep work area clean and well lit. Cluttered or dark areas invite accidents. Do not operate power tools in explosive atmospheres, such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases, or dust.
- **Electrical Safety:** Avoid body contact with earthed or grounded surfaces. Do not expose power tools to rain or wet conditions.
- **Personal Safety:** Always wear eye protection. Use hearing protection when operating for extended periods. Dress properly; avoid loose clothing or jewelry. Keep hair, clothing, and gloves away from moving parts.
- **Tool Use and Care:** Do not force the power tool. Use the correct power tool for your application. Disconnect the battery pack from the power tool before making any adjustments, changing accessories, or storing power tools.
- **Specific Warnings for Patio Cleaner:**
  - Ensure the brush guard is securely in place before operation.
  - Keep hands and feet clear of the rotating brush.
  - Be aware of flying debris; ensure no bystanders are in the immediate vicinity.
  - Do not use on surfaces not intended for this tool, such as delicate paving or loose gravel.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Upon opening the package, ensure all items listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or broken, please contact RYOBI customer service.

- RYOBI RY18PCA-0 Patio Cleaner (Bare Tool)
- Wire Brush (Pre-installed or separate)
- Brush Guard
- Auxiliary Handle
- Instruction Manual

*Note: Battery and charger are sold separately and are not included with this 'bare tool' model.*

## 4. SETUP

---

Follow these steps to assemble your RYOBI RY18PCA-0 Patio Cleaner before first use.

### 1. Attach the Auxiliary Handle:

Slide the auxiliary handle onto the main shaft. Position it at a comfortable height and tighten the locking mechanism securely. Ensure it does not interfere with the telescopic shaft adjustment.

### 2. Install the Brush Guard:

Align the brush guard with the mounting points near the wire brush head. Secure it firmly in place according to the tool's design, typically by snapping or screwing it into position. This guard is crucial for user safety.

### 3. Insert the Battery:

Ensure the battery is fully charged. Slide the 18V ONE+ battery pack into the battery port on the main handle until it clicks securely into place. To remove, press the release latches and pull the battery out.

### 4. Adjust Telescopic Shaft:

Loosen the collar on the telescopic shaft. Extend or retract the shaft to a comfortable operating length that allows you to stand upright without stooping. Tighten the collar firmly to lock the shaft in position.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Before operating, ensure you have read and understood all safety instructions. Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including eye protection.

### 1. Pre-Operation Check:

Verify that the wire brush is securely attached and not damaged. Confirm the brush guard is in place. Check that the battery is fully inserted and locked.

### 2. Starting the Tool:

Hold the patio cleaner firmly with both hands, one on the main handle and one on the auxiliary handle. Press the trigger switch to start the motor and rotate the wire brush.

### 3. Cleaning Technique:

Gently guide the rotating brush along the gaps and joints of your patio. Apply light, consistent pressure. Allow the brush to do the work; do not force it. Move the tool slowly and steadily to ensure thorough cleaning and prevent damage to the paving or the brush.

### 4. Working on Different Surfaces:

For tougher weeds and moss, the standard wire brush is effective. For more delicate surfaces, consider switching to the optional RAC818 nylon brush (sold separately) to avoid scratching or damage.

### 5. Stopping the Tool:

Release the trigger switch to stop the motor. Wait for the brush to come to a complete stop before setting the tool down or performing any adjustments.

*Tip: For best results, clean your patio when it is dry. This helps the brush effectively remove debris and prevents mud from forming.*

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your RYOBI RY18PCA-0 Patio Cleaner.

- **Cleaning the Tool:** After each use, disconnect the battery. Use a dry cloth to wipe down the tool, removing any dirt, dust, or debris. Pay special attention to the brush head area and the guard. Do not use water or harsh chemicals.
- **Brush Inspection and Replacement:** Regularly inspect the wire brush for wear or damage. A worn brush will be less effective and may damage surfaces. To replace the brush, disconnect the battery, remove the old brush by following the instructions in the manual (typically unscrewing or releasing a latch), and install a new RYOBI compatible brush (e.g., wire brush or RAC818 nylon brush).
- **Storage:** Store the patio cleaner in a clean, dry place, out of reach of children and away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures. Remove the battery pack before storing for extended periods.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your RYOBI RY18PCA-0 Patio Cleaner, refer to the table below for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tool does not start	Battery not inserted correctly Battery is discharged Tool malfunction	Ensure battery is fully clicked into place Charge the battery pack Contact RYOBI service center
Brush not spinning effectively	Brush is worn or damaged Excessive pressure applied Debris caught in brush mechanism	Replace the brush Reduce pressure, let the tool do the work Disconnect battery and clear debris from brush head
Tool vibrates excessively	Brush is damaged or unbalanced Loose components	Inspect and replace brush if necessary Check all connections and tighten if loose
