1. Introduction

The ELRO PRO PV40 series offers a professional-grade video door intercom system designed for ease of installation and use. This specific variant is configured for two apartments or homes sharing a single entrance, featuring one outdoor unit with two doorbell buttons and two indoor monitors. The system delivers clear Full HD 1080P video, high-quality audio, and is constructed with robust, durable materials. Key features include a heavy-duty metal outdoor unit with IP66 water resistance, a Full HD 1080P camera with excellent night vision, and motion detection capabilities. The slim design of the outdoor unit (5.5 cm wide) allows for flexible placement. Each indoor monitor is a 7-inch (18 cm) Full HD color screen, equipped with a high-quality microphone and speaker for clear communication. The system supports Micro SD card (not included) for recording images and calls, and features a motion sensor recording function. Additional functionalities include a voicemail feature, a configurable night mode to reduce doorbell volume, 13 selectable ringtones, and the ability to function as a media player or photo frame. It also supports connection to a 12V electronic door opener (not included).

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components listed below are included in your package:

- 1x Doorbell unit with Full HD 1080P camera
- 2x 7-inch (18 cm) monitors
- 2x Monitor mounting brackets
- 2x Power adapters with 1.5 m cords
- 2x 15 m connection cables
- 2x Coupling cables and cable ties
- Screws and wall plugs for mounting




Figure 2: Product packaging for the ELRO PRO PV40 system.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The ELRO PRO PV40 system is designed for straightforward installation. Follow these steps for proper setup:

3.1 Mounting the Outdoor Unit

- 1. Choose a suitable location on your exterior wall or door frame.
- 2. Mount the doorbell unit at a height between 1.35 m and 1.70 m from the ground for optimal viewing angle.
- 3. Secure the unit using the provided screws and wall plugs.

3.2 Mounting the Indoor Monitors

- 1. Select a convenient indoor location for each monitor.
- 2. Attach the monitor mounting bracket to the wall.
- 3. Mount the color monitor onto its bracket.

3.3 Wiring and Connections

Connect the indoor monitors to the outdoor unit using the provided plug & play cables. Ensure all connections are secure.




Figure 6: Simple Plug & Play wiring diagram for connecting the outdoor unit to two monitors.

If you wish to connect an electronic door opener, refer to the following diagram. A 12V electronic door opener is required (not included).




Figure 7: Common wiring configurations for connecting an electronic door opener.




Figure 8: Rear view of the monitor, highlighting connection panel and Micro SD card slot (max. 128 GB, not included).

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Answering a Call

When a visitor presses the doorbell, the indoor monitor will display the camera feed and ring. You can then communicate with the visitor using the integrated microphone and speaker.

4.2 Voicemail Function

The system includes a voicemail feature. If you are not home, visitors can leave a message after the tone, similar to a telephone answering machine. You can also leave a custom message for visitors.

4.3 Recording and Motion Detection

By inserting a Micro SD card (not included), you can record video and images of visitors and calls. The motion detection sensor can be configured to automatically start recording when movement is detected within specified times.

4.4 Night Mode

Activate the configurable night mode to reduce the doorbell volume during nighttime hours, preventing disturbances.

4.5 Ringtones and Multimedia

Choose from 13 different ringtones. The monitor can also be used as a media player or a digital photo frame.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your ELRO PRO PV40 system, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the outdoor unit and indoor monitors with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the surfaces.
- Camera Lens: Keep the camera lens on the outdoor unit clean and free from dust or smudges to maintain clear video quality.
- **Connections:** Periodically check all wiring connections to ensure they are secure and free from corrosion.
- **Software Updates:** Check the manufacturer's website for any available firmware updates to ensure your system has the latest features and security enhancements.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ELRO PRO PV40 system, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure both the outdoor unit and indoor monitors are properly connected to their power adapters and that the power outlets are functional.
- No Video/Audio: Check all connection cables between the outdoor unit and indoor monitors. Ensure they are securely plugged in and not damaged.
- **Poor Video Quality:** Clean the camera lens on the outdoor unit. Ensure there are no obstructions blocking the camera's view. Check lighting conditions; night vision should activate automatically in low light.
- Door Opener Not Working: Verify the wiring to the electronic door opener according to the installation diagram (Figure 7). Ensure the door opener itself is functional and receiving power.
- Motion Detection Not Recording: Ensure a Micro SD card is properly inserted into the monitor and that the motion detection recording feature is enabled in the system settings. Check the sensitivity settings.
- Intermittent Operation: Check for any loose connections or interference from other electronic devices.
