
# 1.1 Package Contents

## 1.2 Connecting the Keyboard

The EvoFox Fireblade TKL keyboard features a USB Plug N' Play design, requiring no additional software installation for basic functionality.

- 1. Locate an available USB port on your computer (PC or Mac).
- 2. Insert the USB connector of the keyboard's braided cable into the USB port.
- 3. The operating system will automatically detect and install the necessary drivers.
- 4. The keyboard's rainbow backlighting will illuminate upon successful connection.




USB connector of the EvoFox Fireblade keyboard with braided cable and magnetic ring, designed for stable data transmission.

# 2. OPERATION

## 2.1 Key Features

## Semi-Mechanical Touch with Floating Keycaps


The keyboard is designed with floating keycaps to provide a semi-mechanical typing experience, offering tactile feedback for enhanced gaming and typing precision.

## TKL (Tenkeyless) Design

## **Rainbow Backlighting with Breathing Effect**

- Enable/Disable Breathing Effect: Press Fn + Light Key (usually the key with a sun icon) to toggle the breathing effect.
- Adjust Brightness: Press Fn + Page Up to increase brightness, and Fn + Page Down to decrease brightness.

## 12 Multimedia Keys

- Fn + F4 : Mute
- Fn + F5 : Stop
- Fn + F6 : Previous Track
- Fn + F7 : Play/Pause
- Fn + F8 : Next Track
- Fn + F9 : Email
- Fn + F10 : Web Browser
- Fn + F11 : My Computer
- Fn + F12 : Calculator

#### Windows Lock Key

The Windows Lock Key prevents accidental presses of the Windows key during gameplay, avoiding interruptions.

• Press the Fn key + Windows Key to enable or disable the Windows Lock function.

#### 3. MAINTENANCE

#### 3.1 Cleaning

To clean your keyboard, disconnect it from the computer. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the keycaps and chassis. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, ensuring no liquid enters the keyboard's internal components. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

#### 3.2 Spill Resistance

The EvoFox Fireblade keyboard features a spill-resistant design. In case of accidental spills, immediately disconnect the keyboard from your computer, invert it to drain any liquid, and allow it to dry completely before reconnecting. While spill-resistant, it is not waterproof, and excessive liquid exposure should be avoided.

## 4. TROUBLESHOOTING

#### 4.1 Keyboard Not Responding

- Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the keyboard and the computer's USB port.
- Try connecting the keyboard to a different USB port.
- Restart your computer.
- Test the keyboard on another computer to determine if the issue is with the keyboard or the computer's port/drivers.

#### 4.2 Backlighting Not Working or Incorrect

- Ensure the keyboard is properly connected.
- Use Fn + Light Key to toggle the breathing effect.
- Use Fn + Page Up / Page Down to adjust brightness.

## 4.3 Keys Not Registering or Ghosting

- Ensure the 19-key anti-ghosting feature is functioning as expected.
- Clean around the affected keys to remove any debris that might be obstructing key presses.
- If the issue persists, contact customer support.
