# Napoleon W010-3560 Baffle Set Instruction Manual

For 1100 Series Wood Stoves

## 1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, maintenance, and care of your Napoleon W010-3560 Baffle Set. This set includes two replacement fiber baffles designed specifically for Napoleon 1100 Series wood stoves. Adhering to these instructions will help ensure the safe and efficient operation of your wood stove.

- Fiber baffles can be brittle. Handle them with care to prevent breakage.
- Refer to your specific Napoleon wood stove's owner's manual for additional safety guidelines and instructions.
- Keep children and pets away from the work area during installation.

#### 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPATIBILITY

The Napoleon W010-3560 Baffle Set consists of two fiber baffles, each approximately 12 inches by 9 inches. These baffles are crucial components in your wood stove, designed to optimize combustion efficiency and reduce emissions by extending the path of exhaust gases. This genuine Napoleon part is compatible with the following Napoleon 1100 Series wood stove models:

- 1100
- 1100C
- 1100C-1
- 1101
- 1150




Figure 1: Napoleon W010-3560 Baffle Set. These are the two fiber baffles included in the set, designed for optimal wood stove performance.




Figure 2: Packaging for the Napoleon W010-3560 Baffle Set, confirming the part number and compatibility with 1100/1101 series stoves.

# 4. Installation Instructions (Setup)

Follow these steps to replace the baffles in your Napoleon 1100 Series wood stove:

- 1. **Preparation:** Ensure the wood stove has completely cooled down and is not in use. Clear any ash or debris from the firebox.
- 2. Open Stove Door: Fully open the main loading door of your wood stove.
- 3. **Locate Existing Baffles:** Identify the current baffles, typically located in the upper part of the firebox, above the combustion chamber. They may be supported by pins or a metal frame.
- 4. **Remove Old Baffles:** Carefully lift and slide out the old baffles. They might be brittle or covered in creosote. Note their orientation for correct installation of the new ones. Dispose of old baffles responsibly.
- 5. **Clean Area:** Gently clean any remaining ash or debris from the baffle support area and the interior of the firebox
- 6. Install New Baffles: Carefully insert the new Napoleon W010-3560 baffles into position. Ensure they are

seated correctly on their supports and are oriented as the original baffles were. The V-shaped indentation on the baffles typically faces downwards or towards the rear of the stove, depending on the specific model. Consult your stove's manual if unsure.

- 7. **Verify Placement:** Double-check that both baffles are securely in place and do not obstruct the flue opening.
- 8. Close Stove Door: Close the wood stove door securely.

Your new baffles are now installed. You may notice a slight odor during the first few burns as the new material cures. Ensure adequate ventilation during this period.

# 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular inspection and maintenance of your baffles are essential for the continued safe and efficient operation of your wood stove.

- **Routine Inspection:** During your regular stove cleaning, visually inspect the baffles for any signs of damage, such as cracks, chips, sagging, or excessive deterioration.
- Creosote Buildup: While baffles help reduce creosote, some buildup can still occur. Gently brush off
  any loose creosote or ash from the baffle surfaces when the stove is cold.
- **Replacement:** Baffles are consumable parts and will eventually require replacement due to normal wear and tear from high temperatures. Replace the baffle set if you observe significant damage, as this can compromise stove efficiency and potentially lead to unsafe operating conditions.

# 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues after baffle installation or during normal operation, consider the following:

- Excessive Smoke in Firebox: Ensure the baffles are correctly seated and not obstructing the flue path. Check for any debris that might have fallen onto the baffles.
- Reduced Heating Efficiency: Damaged or improperly installed baffles can lead to unburnt gases escaping too quickly, reducing heat output. Inspect baffles for cracks or incorrect positioning.
- **Baffle Deterioration:** Minor hairline cracks are common with ceramic fiber baffles over time. However, large cracks, crumbling, or sagging indicate the need for replacement.
- **Difficulty Installing:** If the baffles do not fit, double-check the model compatibility with your specific Napoleon 1100 Series stove. Ensure no old debris is preventing proper seating.
