INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and effective operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your ECHO CS-2511T-14 14-inch 25.0 cc Gas 2-Stroke Top Handle Chainsaw. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the chainsaw to ensure proper use and to prevent injury or damage.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Operating a chainsaw can be dangerous. Always follow safety precautions to minimize risks. Failure to do so may result in serious injury or death.

- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Always wear a safety helmet, eye protection, hearing protection, heavyduty gloves, chainsaw protective trousers or chaps, and safety boots.
- Work Area: Ensure the work area is clear of bystanders, children, and pets. Maintain a firm footing and balance.
- Fuel Handling: Mix and handle fuel in a well-ventilated area, away from ignition sources. Do not smoke while fueling.
- **Kickback:** Be aware of kickback, which can occur when the moving chain at the tip of the guide bar contacts an object, or when the wood closes in and pinches the saw chain in the cut.
- Inspection: Before each use, inspect the chainsaw for loose fasteners, damaged parts, and proper chain tension.

• Never operate the chainsaw with one hand. This chainsaw is designed for two-handed operation.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

1. Guide Bar and Chain Installation

- 1. Ensure the engine is off and the chain brake is disengaged.
- 2. Remove the chain cover by loosening the two nuts.
- 3. Place the chain around the clutch drum, ensuring the cutting edges face forward on the top of the guide bar.
- 4. Fit the guide bar onto the studs, aligning the chain drive links with the groove in the guide bar.
- 5. Replace the chain cover and hand-tighten the nuts. Do not fully tighten yet.
- 6. Adjust chain tension using the tensioning screw. The chain should be snug against the guide bar, but still able to be pulled freely by hand.
- 7. Fully tighten the chain cover nuts.

2. Fuel and Chain Oil

This chainsaw uses a 2-stroke engine and requires a specific fuel mixture and chain lubricant.

- Fuel Mixture: Use fresh, unleaded gasoline mixed with high-quality 2-stroke engine oil at the ratio specified in the full operator's manual (typically 50:1 for ECHO).
- Chain Oil: Fill the chain oil tank with good quality bar and chain oil. Do not use waste oil or motor oil.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Starting the Engine (Cold Start)

- 1. Place the chainsaw on a firm, flat surface.
- 2. Engage the chain brake.
- 3. Push the primer bulb 5-7 times until fuel is visible.
- 4. Pull the choke lever to the FULL CHOKE position.
- 5. Pull the starter handle firmly until the engine fires (usually 1-3 pulls).
- 6. Push the choke lever to the HALF CHOKE position.
- 7. Pull the starter handle again until the engine starts and runs.
- 8. Once running, push the choke lever to the RUN position.
- 9. Disengage the chain brake and allow the engine to warm up for a few moments before use.

2. Cutting Techniques

- · Always hold the chainsaw firmly with both hands.
- Maintain a stable stance.
- · Avoid cutting with the tip of the guide bar to prevent kickback.
- Let the saw do the work; do not force it through the wood.
- · Be aware of falling branches and shifting logs.

3. Stopping the Engine

To stop the engine, simply push the stop switch to the "OFF" position.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your chainsaw. Always ensure the engine is off and cool before performing any maintenance.

• Chain Tension: Check chain tension frequently. A properly tensioned chain should be snug but still able to be

pulled around the guide bar by hand.

- Chain Sharpening: A sharp chain is crucial for safe and efficient cutting. Sharpen the chain regularly or replace it when dull. Refer to the full manual for specific sharpening angles and file sizes.
- Air Filter: Clean the air filter regularly, especially in dusty conditions. A clogged air filter can reduce engine performance.
- Spark Plug: Inspect the spark plug periodically. Clean or replace it if it's fouled or worn.
- Guide Bar: Clean the guide bar groove and oil holes. Flip the guide bar periodically to ensure even wear.
- Sprocket: Inspect the drive sprocket for wear and replace if necessary.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine won't start	No fuel, incorrect starting procedure, fouled spark plug, clogged fuel filter.	Check fuel level and mixture. Follow cold/warm start procedure. Inspect/clean/replace spark plug. Check/replace fuel filter.
Engine runs poorly/lacks power	Clogged air filter, dull chain, incorrect fuel mixture, carburetor issues.	Clean air filter. Sharpen or replace chain. Ensure correct fuel mixture. Consult a service technician for carburetor adjustments.
Chain not cutting efficiently	Dull chain, incorrect chain tension, worn guide bar.	Sharpen or replace chain. Adjust chain tension. Inspect guide bar for wear.
Chain oil not flowing	Empty oil tank, clogged oil port, damaged oil pump.	Fill oil tank. Clean oil port. Consult a service technician for oil pump issues.
