## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

### Introduction

## Setup and Installation

## Usage and Function

The Dometic 3106992.062B S/T 45 Degree Bracket Kit serves as a structural support or mounting component. Once correctly installed, it provides a stable and secure attachment point or structural reinforcement at a 45-degree angle, as per its design. This component does not have active operational functions; its purpose is passive support.

## Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and continued performance of your bracket kit, periodic inspection and maintenance are recommended.

- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check the bracket and its mounting points for any signs of wear, corrosion, or loosening of fasteners.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the bracket with a mild soap and water solution, then rinse thoroughly and dry. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish.
- **Tighten Fasteners:** Re-tighten any loose fasteners to prevent movement or failure.
- **Corrosion Protection:** If installed in an environment prone to corrosion, consider applying a suitable corrosion-inhibiting coating or lubricant to exposed metal parts, if appropriate for the material.

## Troubleshooting

Most issues related to a bracket kit are typically associated with installation or physical damage.

- **Bracket is Loose:** Check all mounting fasteners. Ensure they are tightened to the correct torque. Inspect the mounting surface for damage or instability.
- **Bracket is Damaged:** If the bracket shows signs of bending, cracking, or severe corrosion, it should be replaced immediately to prevent potential failure.
- **Incorrect Angle/Position:** Re-evaluate the installation steps and ensure the bracket is positioned and oriented correctly according to your application's requirements.
