1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The HABA Stacking Game Fox is a wooden toy designed to develop fine motor skills and concentration in children aged 2 years and older. This game features a wobbly meadow base and various stacking stones shaped like animals and sun rays, encouraging creative play and strategic stacking.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening the package, verify that all components are present:

- 1 x Wobble Meadow Base
- 10 x Stacking Stones (various shapes and designs)
- 10 x Playing Tiles

3. SETUP

The HABA Stacking Game Fox requires minimal setup. Simply remove all components from their packaging. The game is ready for play once all pieces are laid out on a flat, stable surface.

1. Place the green wobble meadow base on a flat, stable surface.
2. Arrange the 10 stacking stones and 10 playing tiles nearby, within easy reach of all players.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (GAME VARIANTS)

The HABA Stacking Game Fox offers two primary ways to play, catering to different levels of structured engagement:

4.1. Free Play

In free play, children can stack the wooden stones on the wobble meadow base in any order or configuration they choose. This variant encourages creativity, experimentation with balance, and independent exploration of the toy's properties. The goal is simply to stack as many stones as possible without the tower collapsing.

4.2. Guided Play (Using Playing Tiles)

For a more structured game, use the playing tiles. This variant introduces an element of chance and strategy:

1. Shuffle the 10 playing tiles and place them face down in a stack.
2. Players take turns drawing a tile.
3. The drawn tile indicates which type of stacking stone (e.g., fox, bee, bird, ladybug, sun) the player must place on the wobble meadow base.

4. Carefully place the corresponding stacking stone onto the meadow base. The objective is to maintain the balance of the meadow and prevent any stones from falling.
5. If a player causes any stones to fall, their turn ends, and the game continues. The game can be played until all stones are stacked, or until a predetermined number of falls occurs.

This guided play variant promotes fine motor skills, concentration, and strategic thinking as players consider where to place their stone to maintain balance.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and hygiene of your HABA Stacking Game Fox:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wooden pieces and cardboard tiles with a damp cloth. Do not immerse in water or use harsh cleaning agents, as this may damage the wood and paint.
- **Storage:** Store the game in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures, to prevent warping or fading of the wood.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all pieces for any signs of wear, splintering, or damage. Discontinue use if any piece becomes damaged to prevent injury.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This is a simple mechanical toy, and issues are rare. Most "problems" relate to gameplay challenges:

- **Stones frequently fall:** This is part of the game's challenge. Encourage players to try different placement strategies, observe how the base wobbles, and practice gentle handling. For younger children, start with fewer stones or use the free play variant.
- **Lost playing tiles:** If playing tiles are lost, the game can still be enjoyed using the free play method. Alternatively, create new tiles with drawings of the stacking stones.
- **Damaged wooden pieces:** If a wooden piece splinters or breaks, discontinue use immediately to prevent injury. Contact HABA customer support for replacement options.
