INTRODUCTION

SETUP

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3. **Rinse:** Gently tilt the bottle to allow water to flow through the cap's holes. Direct the stream to rinse soap or shampoo from your baby's hair and body.
4. **Control Flow:** The design of the cap provides a controlled, gentle flow, ideal for sensitive areas like the face and head.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your rinse bottle.

- **After Each Use:** Empty any remaining water from the bottle.
- **Cleaning:** Wash the bottle and cap with warm, soapy water. A mild dish soap is suitable.
- **Rinsing:** Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove all soap.
- **Drying:** Allow all components to air dry completely before reassembling or storing to prevent mold or mildew growth. Store in a dry place.
- **Product Care Instructions:** Wipe with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your rinse bottle, consider the following common solutions:

- **Slow Water Flow:**

Possible Cause: Mineral buildup or debris in the cap's holes.

Solution: Detach the cap and clean the holes using a small brush (e.g., a soft toothbrush or pipe cleaner) and warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.

- **Leaking from Cap:**

Possible Cause: Cap not securely fastened or damaged.

Solution: Ensure the cap is twisted on tightly and correctly aligned. Inspect the cap for any cracks or damage. If damaged, replacement may be necessary.
