Nania Racer Child Booster Seat

INSTRUCTION MANUAL - MODEL 876186

1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the correct installation, use, and maintenance of your Nania Racer Child Booster Seat. This car seat is designed for children in Group 1/2/3, weighing between 9 and 36 kg. Please read these instructions carefully before using the product and keep them for future reference. Proper installation and use are crucial for your child's safety.

2. Safety Information

- The Nania Racer car seat is designed for forward-facing use only, installed on the rear seat of the vehicle using a 3-point safety belt.
- For children weighing 9 to 18 kg (Group 1), the child must be secured using the integrated 5-point harness system.
- For children weighing 15 to 36 kg (Group 2/3), the child must be secured using the vehicle's 3-point safety belt, with the car seat acting as a booster.
- Ensure the car seat is always correctly installed and secured, even when not occupied by a child.
- Never leave your child unattended in the car seat.
- Do not modify the car seat or use accessories not approved by the manufacturer.
- In the event of an accident, the car seat must be replaced, even if there is no visible damage.
- This product features side protection for enhanced safety.

3. Product Overview

The Nania Racer is a versatile child booster seat designed for comfort and safety across multiple age and weight groups. Key features include:

- **5-Point Harness:** For children 9-18 kg, with double shoulder adjustment.

- **Adjustable Headrest:** Multiple positions to adapt to your child's growth.
- **Side Protection:** Enhanced safety in case of side impact.
- **Recline Position:** One recline position for added comfort.
- **Removable Cover:** For easy cleaning and maintenance.
- **ADAC 3-Star Rating:** Recognized for satisfactory safety performance.

4. Setup and Installation

The Nania Racer car seat is installed using the vehicle's 3-point safety belt. It must always be installed in a forward-facing position on the rear seat of the vehicle.

Installation Steps:

1. Place the car seat on the desired rear vehicle seat, ensuring it sits flat against the vehicle's backrest.
2. Route the vehicle's 3-point safety belt through the designated guides on the car seat. The lap portion of the belt should pass over the child's hips, and the diagonal portion should pass over the child's shoulder and across the chest.
3. Buckle the vehicle's safety belt and pull it taut to remove any slack. Ensure the car seat is firmly secured and does not move excessively.
4. For Group 1 (9-18 kg), ensure the integrated 5-point harness is correctly adjusted and secured around the child.
5. For Group 2/3 (15-36 kg), the 5-point harness should be removed, and the child secured directly with the vehicle's 3-point safety belt.

5. Operating Instructions

Adjusting the Headrest:

The headrest can be adjusted to multiple positions to ensure optimal comfort and safety as your child grows. To adjust, locate the adjustment mechanism (usually a lever or button) at the back or top of the headrest. Press the mechanism and slide the headrest up or down until it is at the correct height, ensuring the shoulder straps (if used) are at or slightly above your child's shoulders.

Recline Position:

The Nania Racer offers one recline position for enhanced comfort. To engage the recline, locate the recline adjustment lever, typically found at the front or base of the seat. Follow the instructions provided on the seat itself or in the detailed manual for specific recline operation.

Securing Your Child:

The method of securing your child depends on their weight:

- **9-18 kg (Group 1):** Use the integrated 5-point harness. Ensure the harness straps are snug against your child's body, without twists, and the buckle is securely fastened. The chest clip should be at armpit level.
- **15-36 kg (Group 2/3):** Remove the 5-point harness. Secure your child using the vehicle's 3-point safety belt. Ensure the lap belt is low on the hips, touching the thighs, and the shoulder belt crosses the center of the shoulder and chest, not the neck or face.

6. Maintenance

Cleaning the Cover:

The car seat cover is removable and washable by hand. Please follow these steps:

1. Carefully remove the fabric cover from the car seat frame.
2. Hand wash the cover using mild soap and cold water. Do not use bleach or harsh detergents.
3. Allow the cover to air dry completely before reattaching it to the car seat. Do not tumble dry.

Cleaning the Frame:

The plastic parts of the car seat can be cleaned with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

7. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Nania Racer car seat, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Difficulty Installing:** Ensure the vehicle's 3-point safety belt is routed correctly through all designated guides and pulled taut. Refer to the 'Setup and Installation' section.
- **Harness/Belt Too Loose:** Check that the harness adjuster strap (for 9-18kg) or the vehicle belt buckle is fully engaged and tightened. Ensure no slack remains in the straps.
- **Headrest Not Adjusting:** Verify that the adjustment lever or button is fully engaged when attempting to move the headrest. Ensure no fabric or debris is obstructing the mechanism.
- **Child Uncomfortable:** Check that the headrest is at the correct height for your child's shoulders and that the harness or vehicle belt is not twisted or digging into their skin.
