PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Cadac Meridian 3 Propane Gas BBQ Grill is designed for outdoor cooking, featuring a durable stainless steel construction and a 2-door cart for convenience. This grill is equipped with three burners, providing substantial cooking power for various grilling needs. Its design focuses on efficient heat distribution and ease of cleaning.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Cadac Meridian 3 grill requires assembly. It is recommended to have two people for assembly. Refer to the detailed assembly instructions provided in the packaging for step-by-step guidance.

Key Assembly Features:

- **Enclosed 2-Door Cart:** Provides hidden storage for the propane tank and other accessories.
- **Folding Side Tables:** Offer additional workspace for food preparation and fold down for compact storage.

- **Wheels and Castors:** Two crack-resistant rubber wheels and two castors facilitate easy movement, with brake levers for stability.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Ignition Procedure:

1. Ensure the propane tank is securely connected and the gas supply valve is open.
2. Open the grill lid.
3. Push and turn a control knob to the HIGH position.
4. Press the automatic piezo ignition button (if separate) or continue holding the knob in for integrated ignition until the burner ignites.
5. Once ignited, release the knob and adjust to the desired heat setting.
6. If a burner does not ignite within 5 seconds, turn the knob to OFF, wait 5 minutes, and repeat the process.

Cooking with ThermoGrill Racks:

The grill features ThermoGrill non-stick cooking grates designed for quick heat-up time, uniform surface temperature, and even heat distribution. This ensures consistent cooking results across the entire grilling surface.

Temperature Monitoring:

The double-lined stainless steel dome lid is equipped with a high-quality built-in thermometer to monitor the internal temperature of the grill, allowing for precise cooking control.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your grill and ensure optimal performance.

After Each Use:

- **Cooking Grates:** Once the grill has cooled, brush off any food residue from the ThermoGrill racks. For stubborn

residue, use warm soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge.

- **Fat Cup:** The grill features an easy-clean fat cup to collect drippings. Empty and clean this cup regularly to prevent grease buildup and potential flare-ups.

Periodic Maintenance:

- **Exterior Surfaces:** Clean stainless steel surfaces with a mild detergent and a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Burners and Flame Tamers:** Periodically inspect burners and flame tamers for blockages or damage. Clean as necessary.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the grill in a dry, protected area. Consider using a grill cover to protect it from the elements.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner does not ignite	No gas flow, clogged burner port, faulty igniter.	Check propane tank level and connection. Clean burner ports. Inspect igniter electrode and wire.
Uneven heating	Clogged burner ports, uneven flame tamers, low gas pressure.	Clean burner ports. Ensure flame tamers are correctly positioned. Check gas regulator.
Grease flare-ups	Excessive grease buildup, high heat.	Clean fat cup and cooking grates regularly. Reduce heat setting.
Lid not sealing properly	Misalignment, damage to lid or hinges.	Inspect lid and hinges for damage or misalignment. Adjust if possible or contact support.
