PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The TUINYO TP19 headphones feature a comfortable over-ear design with soft memory-protein earmuffs and an adjustable stainless steel headband for a perfect fit. Controls are intuitively placed on the earcup.

Key Features:

- High Fidelity Stereo Sound: Powered by 40mm neodymium drivers for immersive audio.
- Comfortable Design: Memory-protein ear cushions and adjustable headband for extended wear.
- Dual Mode: Supports both wireless Bluetooth and wired 3.5mm audio connections.
- Long Battery Life: Up to 40 hours of playtime on a single charge.

SETUP

1. Charging the Headphones

- 1. Connect the micro USB charging cable to the charging port on the headphones.
- 2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
- 3. The LED indicator will show charging status (typically red while charging, off or blue when fully charged).

4. A full charge takes approximately 2-2.5 hours and provides up to 40 hours of music playtime.

2. Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the Power button (usually the multi-function button) for a few seconds until the LED indicator lights up and you hear a power-on prompt.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button again for a few seconds until the LED indicator turns off and you hear a power-off prompt.

3. Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 5-7 seconds until the LED indicator flashes red and blue alternately, indicating pairing mode.
- 3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, PC), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 4. Select "TP 19" from the list of devices.
- 5. Once paired, the LED indicator will flash blue slowly, and you will hear a connection confirmation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wireless Mode

- Play/Pause: Press the Multi-function button once.
- Volume Up: Press the "+" button.
- Volume Down: Press the "-" button.
- Next Track: Press and hold the "+" button.
- Previous Track: Press and hold the "-" button.

2. Wired Mode

When the battery is low or if you prefer a wired connection, you can use the included 3.5mm audio cable.

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the audio input port on the headphones.
- 2. Connect the other end to your audio device's 3.5mm jack.
- 3. In wired mode, controls on the headphones may be limited, and playback will be controlled by your connected device.

3. Call Functions

- Answer/End Call: Press the Multi-function button once.
- Reject Call: Press and hold the Multi-function button for 2 seconds.
- Redial Last Number: Double-press the Multi-function button.

4. Voice Assistant

The headphones support voice-enabled assistants like Siri. Press the Multi-function button twice to activate your device's voice assistant.

5. Sound Effects (EQ Mode)

The headphones feature multiple sound effects (EQ modes) to customize your listening experience. Press the EQ button (often labeled "EQ" or a similar icon) to cycle through available modes such as Normal, Rock, Pop, Classic, Jazz, and Country.

MAINTENANCE

- Store the headphones in the protective case when not in use to prevent damage.
- Keep the charging port and audio jack free of dust and debris.
- Avoid exposing the headphones to direct sunlight or extreme heat for extended periods.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents on the headphones.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Headphones won't power on.	Ensure the headphones are fully charged. Connect to a power source and try again.
Cannot pair with device.	 Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing red/blue LED). Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Move headphones closer to your device (within 10 meters). Forget "TP 19" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.

Problem	Solution
No sound in wireless mode.	 Check volume levels on both headphones and connected device. Ensure headphones are successfully paired. Try restarting both the headphones and your device.
No sound in wired mode.	 Ensure the 3.5mm audio cable is securely connected to both devices. Check volume levels on your audio device. Test with a different 3.5mm cable if available.
