SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Boytone BT-424FN speaker system.

1. Speaker Connection:

1. Connect the two satellite speakers to the corresponding audio output jacks on the rear of the main subwoofer unit. Ensure a secure connection.

2. Power Connection:

1. Plug the AC power cord from the main unit into a standard AC 110/220V wall outlet.

3. Remote Control Setup:

1. Insert the two AAA batteries into the remote control, observing the correct polarity (+/-).

4. Initial Power On:

1. Press the power button on the main unit or the remote control to turn on the system. The LED display will light up.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Learn how to use the various functions of your Boytone BT-424FN speaker system.

1. Basic Operation:

- Power On/Off: Press the 'ST-BY/M' button on the main unit or the power button on the remote.
- Volume Control: Rotate the 'VOLUME' knob on the front panel or use the 'VOL+' and 'VOL-' buttons on the remote control.
- **Source Selection:** Press the 'SOURCE' button on the main unit or the remote to cycle through input modes: Bluetooth, FM, USB, SD, AUX.
- **Tone Control:** Use the 'TONE' button on the main unit or remote to adjust bass and treble settings (if available).





2. Bluetooth Mode:

- 1. Select 'Bluetooth' mode using the 'SOURCE' button. The LED display will show 'BT' or a similar indicator.
- 2. On your Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.

- 3. Select 'BT-424FN' or 'Boytone' from the list of devices.
- 4. Once paired, you can play audio from your device through the speaker system.

3. FM Radio Mode:

- 1. Select 'FM' mode using the 'SOURCE' button.
- 2. Use the 'TUN+/-' buttons on the main unit or the remote to manually tune to a desired radio station.
- 3. To auto-scan and save stations, press and hold the 'PLAY/PAUSE' button (often doubles as auto-scan in FM mode) on the remote or main unit.

4. USB/SD Card Mode:

- 1. Insert a USB flash drive or SD card containing MP3 audio files into the respective port.
- 2. Select 'USB' or 'SD' mode using the 'SOURCE' button. The system will automatically begin playing the first compatible audio file.
- 3. Use the 'PREV/NEXT' buttons on the main unit or remote to skip tracks. Use 'PLAY/PAUSE' to control

playback.

5. AUX Mode:

- 1. Connect your external audio device (e.g., MP3 player, TV, computer) to the 'AUX' input jack on the main unit using the provided 3.5mm audio cable.
- 2. Select 'AUX' mode using the 'SOURCE' button.
- 3. Control playback and volume directly from your connected external device.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity of your speaker system.

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior surfaces of the unit. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- **Dust:** Regularly dust the speaker grilles and vents to prevent accumulation that could affect sound quality and ventilation.
- **Storage:** If storing the unit for an extended period, unplug it from the power outlet and store it in a cool, dry place.
- Avoid Liquids: Keep liquids away from the unit to prevent damage to internal components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Boytone BT-424FN, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not connected; Power outlet not active	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in; Try a different power outlet
No sound	Volume too low; Incorrect source selected; Speakers not connected	Increase volume; Press 'SOURCE' to select correct input; Check speaker connections
Bluetooth pairing failed	Device too far; Bluetooth not enabled on device; Speaker not in pairing mode	Move device closer; Enable Bluetooth on your device; Ensure speaker is in Bluetooth mode and discoverable
FM radio static	Weak signal; Antenna not extended	Adjust antenna position; Try auto-scanning for stronger stations
USB/SD not playing	Unsupported file format; Corrupted files; Incorrect mode selected	Ensure files are MP3 format; Try a different USB/SD card; Select 'USB' or 'SD' mode
Remote control not working	Batteries drained or incorrectly inserted; Obstruction between remote and unit	Replace batteries and check polarity; Remove any obstructions; Point remote directly at the unit's sensor
