## INTRODUCTION

---

Get to work playing with the Go! Go! Smart Wheels Construction Vehicle Pack. This pack includes three interactive construction vehicles: Ben the Bulldozer, Doug the Dump Truck, and Tony the Tow Truck.

Designed for ages 1-5 years, these vehicles introduce new words, songs, and phrases through engaging play.

## Key Features:

- Toddlers will love hearing new words as they make friends with Ben the Bulldozer, Doug the Dump Truck and Tony the Tow Truck.
- Each vehicle has a mechanical part that moves for fine-motor development.
- Press the light-up windshield on each vehicle to hear phrases, songs, melodies, and the letters “B”, “D” and “T”.
- Drive these vehicles on Go! Go! Smart Wheels playsets (sold separately) with SmartPoint technology and they will respond with unique phrases and sounds.

## BATTERY INSTALLATION

---

Each vehicle requires 2 AAA batteries. Batteries are included for demo purposes only; new batteries are recommended for regular use.

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of each vehicle.
2. Using a screwdriver, open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 2 new AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the battery compartment cover and secure with the screw.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Basic Play:

1. Remove each vehicle from its packaging.
2. Press the light-up windshield on each vehicle to hear phrases, songs, melodies, and the letters 'B', 'D', and 'T'.
3. Drive the vehicles around to trigger fun role-play sound effects.

### SmartPoint Interaction:

- Take the vehicles to a Go! Go! Smart Wheels playset (sold separately) and discover more phrases, songs, sounds, and lights as they race over the SmartPoint locations.




Image: A VTech Go! Go! Smart Wheels vehicle positioned on a playset, interacting with a SmartPoint location.

## Mechanical Parts:

- **Ben the Bulldozer:** The front scoop can be manually moved up and down.
- **Doug the Dump Truck:** The dump bed can be manually tilted to unload.
- **Tony the Tow Truck:** The tow hook can be manually raised and lowered.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your VTech Go! Go! Smart Wheels Construction Vehicle Pack, please follow these guidelines:

- Wipe the vehicles with a damp cloth to clean. Do not immerse in water.
- Avoid exposing the toys to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for extended periods.
- Remove batteries if the toys will not be used for a long time to prevent leakage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If your VTech Go! Go! Smart Wheels vehicles are not functioning as expected, please try the following:

- **No sound or lights:** Check if the batteries are correctly installed and replace them with new ones if necessary. Ensure the on/off switch is in the 'on' position.
- **Intermittent function:** This may indicate low battery power. Replace the batteries.
- **SmartPoint interaction issues:** Ensure the vehicles are placed correctly on SmartPoint locations on compatible playsets. Clean the SmartPoint sensors on the vehicles and playset if they appear dirty.
