Welcome to Your Stander Let's Go Indoor Rollator

Thank you for choosing the Stander Let's Go Indoor Rollator. This lightweight, four-wheel Euro style walker is designed to provide stable and convenient mobility within your home. Its narrow frame, integrated tray, and storage basket offer practical assistance for daily activities. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use, maintenance, and care of your new rollator.

- Ensure all parts are securely fastened and the rollator is stable before each use.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of the rollator (refer to specifications).
- Always engage the brakes when standing still or transferring to and from the rollator.
- Be aware of your surroundings and avoid obstacles.
- Do not use the rollator on uneven surfaces, stairs, or escalators.
- Keep hands and fingers clear of moving parts, especially during folding and unfolding.
- Regularly inspect the wheels, brakes, and frame for any signs of wear or damage.

SETUP AND INITIAL ASSEMBLY

The Stander Let's Go Indoor Rollator is designed for minimal assembly. It typically arrives ready for use with simple unfolding and handle adjustment.

Unfolding the Rollator

- 1. Place the rollator on a flat, stable surface.
- 2. Gently pull the sides of the frame apart until it fully extends and locks into place. Ensure all locking mechanisms are engaged.

Adjusting Handle Height

The single padded handle is height adjustable to suit individual user needs, ranging from 32.5 to 37.5 inches tall.

- 1. Locate the easy adjustment knob on the handle stem.
- 2. Loosen the knob and slide the handle to the desired height. The handle should be at wrist level when standing upright with arms relaxed.
- 3. Tighten the knob securely to lock the handle in position.

OPERATING YOUR ROLLATOR

Maneuvering and Braking

The Let's Go Rollator features four 6-inch wheels, with front swivel wheels for enhanced maneuverability in tight spaces. The braking system provides stability and control.

- To move, push the rollator forward while maintaining a comfortable distance behind it.
- To slow down or stop, gently squeeze the brake levers located on the handle.
- To engage the parking brake (lock the wheels), push the brake levers down until they click into place. This is essential when standing still or using the tray.
- To release the parking brake, pull the brake levers up.

Utilizing the Tray and Storage Basket

The rollator comes equipped with a 16 by 14.5 inch removable tray and a fabric basket, ideal for carrying personal items, food, or beverages.

- The tray can be placed on top of the rollator frame to transport items or serve as a small table, for example, when eating meals from your favorite chair.
- The fabric basket is located beneath the tray and provides additional storage for larger items.
- Always ensure items are securely placed on the tray or in the basket to prevent spills or falls.

FOLDING FOR STORAGE

The lightweight 14.8-pound frame of the rollator is designed to fold easily for convenient storage and transport.

- 1. Remove any items from the tray and storage basket.
- 2. Lift the central folding mechanism (if applicable, refer to specific model instructions for exact location).
- 3. Gently push the sides of the rollator together until it collapses into its folded position.
- 4. The rollator folds to an 11-inch width, allowing for compact storage in narrow spaces.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and safe operation of your rollator.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the frame and handle with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners. The tray can be washed with soap and water.
- Wheels: Periodically check the wheels for debris (hair, lint) and clean as necessary to ensure smooth rolling.
- **Brakes:** Test the brakes regularly to ensure they engage properly and hold the rollator securely. If the brakes feel loose or do not engage effectively, they may need adjustment. Consult a qualified technician or the manufacturer's support for brake adjustments.
- Frame: Inspect the aluminum frame for any cracks, bends, or signs of damage. Do not use the rollator if the frame is compromised.
- Storage: Store the rollator in a dry place, away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your rollator.

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---------------------------------------|--|---|
| Rollator does not roll smoothly. | Debris in wheels; loose wheel axle. | Clean wheels of any obstructions. Check if wheel axles are tight. |
| Brakes are not engaging or holding. | Brake cable too loose; worn brake pads. | Tighten brake cable (consult manual or technician). Inspect and replace worn brake pads if necessary. |
| Handle feels wobbly after adjustment. | Adjustment knob not fully tightened. | Ensure the handle adjustment knob is securely tightened. |
| Rollator does not fold completely. | Obstruction; folding mechanism not fully disengaged. | Check for anything blocking the folding mechanism. Ensure the folding release is fully activated. |
