1. Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your QFX BT-1956 Bluetooth 1956 Pickup Truck Replica Speaker. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

2. Product Overview

The QFX BT-1956 is a portable Bluetooth speaker designed in the style of a 1956 pickup truck. It features integrated LED lights, multiple audio input options, and hands-free calling capabilities.

Key Features:

- · Bluetooth Wireless Connectivity
- Dual 3-inch Speakers for clear audio
- Hands-Free Phone Link with Built-in Microphone
- FM Radio Functionality
- USB and TF Card Ports for direct media playback
- Integrated LED Party Lights
- Rechargeable Battery
- True Wireless Stereo (TWS) Pairing for enhanced sound




Figure 2.2: Side view of the QFX BT-1956 speaker.

3. Setup

3.1 Charging the Speaker:

Before first use, fully charge the speaker. Connect the supplied USB cable to the DC 5V charging port on the rear of the speaker and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer USB port. The charging indicator will show the charging status.

3.2 Power On/Off:

Press and hold the **POWER** button located on the rear panel to turn the speaker on or off. A startup sound will indicate the device is active.

4. Operating Instructions

4.1 Bluetooth Pairing:

- 1. Ensure the speaker is powered on and in Bluetooth mode. The display will show "BLUE" and an audible prompt will confirm Bluetooth mode.
- 2. On your mobile device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 3. Select "BT-1956" from the list of devices.
- 4. Once paired, the speaker will confirm with an audible notification.




Figure 4.1: Bluetooth pairing with a smartphone.

4.2 Hands-Free Calling:

When connected via Bluetooth, the built-in microphone allows for hands-free calls. Press the **Play/Pause** button to answer or end a call.

4.3 FM Radio:

1. Press the **MODE** button (M/S) to switch to FM Radio mode.

- $2. \ \ Press \ and \ hold \ the {\bf Play/Pause} \ button \ to \ automatically \ scan \ and \ save \ available \ FM \ stations.$
- 3. Use the **Previous/Next Track** buttons to navigate between saved stations.

4.4 USB/TF Card Playback:

Insert a USB drive or TF card into the corresponding port on the rear panel. The speaker will automatically detect the storage device and begin playing audio files. Use the **Play/Pause** and **Previous/Next Track** buttons to control playback.

4.5 LED Party Lights:

The speaker features integrated LED lights. These lights typically activate automatically with audio playback. Specific controls for light modes may be available via the mode button or a dedicated light button if present (refer to Figure 2.3 for button layout).

4.6 True Wireless Stereo (TWS) Pairing:

To pair two BT-1956 speakers for stereo sound:

- 1. Ensure both speakers are powered on and in Bluetooth mode, but not yet paired to any device.
- 2. On one speaker (this will be the master), press and hold the MODE button (M/S) until you hear a pairing tone.
- 3. The two speakers will connect automatically. Once connected, they will indicate TWS pairing is successful.

4. Now, connect your mobile device to the master speaker via Bluetooth as described in section 4.1.

4.7 Volume Control:

Adjust the volume using the **Volume Up (+)** and **Volume Down (-)** buttons on the rear panel, or directly from your connected Bluetooth device.

5. Maintenance

- Keep the speaker away from water, moisture, and extreme temperatures.
- Clean the speaker with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the speaker to strong impacts.

• When not in use for extended periods, store the speaker in a cool, dry place and charge it periodically to maintain battery health.

6. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the speaker using the provided USB cable.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	Speaker is not in pairing mode or too far from device.	Ensure speaker is in Bluetooth mode and within 10 meters of your device. Restart both devices and try again.
No sound.	Volume too low, or incorrect mode selected.	Increase volume on both speaker and connected device. Ensure correct input mode (Bluetooth, FM, USB, TF) is selected.
FM radio reception is poor.	Weak signal.	Move the speaker to a location with better signal reception.




Figure 7.1: Product Dimensions.
