INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of the AXIS P1447-LE Network Camera. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and safety.

The AXIS P1447-LE Network Camera is designed for surveillance applications, offering excellent image quality at 5-megapixel resolution and a 16:9 aspect ratio.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AXIS P1447-LE is a robust network camera built for reliable outdoor surveillance. Key features include:

- 5 MP resolution for detailed video capture.
- 16:9 format for wide-angle viewing.
- Low light technology (Night Color) for improved performance in challenging lighting conditions.
- Outdoor suitability with IP54 international protection rating.
- Wired connectivity and ONVIF compatibility.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all items listed in the packing list are present. Retain the original packaging for future transport or storage.

2. Mounting the Camera

The AXIS P1447-LE supports ceiling mount installation. Choose a stable mounting surface that can support the camera's weight and provide an optimal field of view.

1. Drill pilot holes according to the mounting template (if provided).
2. Secure the mounting bracket to the surface using appropriate screws and anchors.
3. Attach the camera body to the mounting bracket, ensuring it is firmly locked in place.

3. Power and Network Connection

Connect the camera to a power source (AC/DC) and to your network via an Ethernet cable. The camera supports wired connectivity and ONVIF protocol for integration with network video recorders (NVRs) or video management systems (VMS).

- Ensure the power supply meets the camera's specifications.
- Use a reliable Ethernet cable for stable network connection.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Initial Access and Configuration

Upon first power-up, the camera will acquire an IP address from your network's DHCP server. Use the AXIS IP Utility or your VMS to discover the camera on the network.

1. Access the camera's web interface using its IP address in a web browser.
2. Log in with the default credentials (refer to the camera's packaging or quick start guide for default username and password). **It is highly recommended to change the default password immediately for security.**
3. Configure network settings, video resolution (up to 5 MP), frame rate (30 fps), and image quality settings.

2. Video Surveillance and Recording

The camera is primarily used for surveillance. It supports motion-only alert types and can be integrated with various surveillance platforms.

- Set up motion detection zones and sensitivity within the camera's web interface or your VMS.
- Configure recording schedules and storage locations (e.g., NVR, NAS, or cloud storage).
- Utilize the optical zoom feature for detailed viewing of specific areas.

3. Remote Control and Monitoring

The camera can be controlled and monitored remotely. It is compatible with Amazon Alexa for certain control functions, and general remote control is available via its web interface or integrated VMS.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your AXIS P1447-LE Network Camera.

- **Lens Cleaning:** Periodically clean the camera lens with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a mild lens cleaning solution. Avoid abrasive materials that could scratch the lens.
- **Housing Inspection:** Inspect the camera housing and mounting bracket for any signs of damage, corrosion, or loose connections. Tighten screws as needed.
- **Firmware Updates:** Check the manufacturer's website regularly for firmware updates. Keeping the firmware updated can improve performance, add new features, and address security vulnerabilities.
- **Environmental Checks:** Ensure the camera's operating environment remains within specified temperature and humidity ranges. Clear any obstructions that might block the camera's view or ventilation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section provides solutions to common issues you might encounter with your network camera.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No video feed	Power issue Network cable disconnected Incorrect IP address	Check power supply and connections. Verify Ethernet cable is securely connected. Use AXIS IP Utility to find the correct IP address.
Poor image quality	Dirty lens Incorrect resolution settings Insufficient lighting	Clean the camera lens. Adjust resolution to 5 MP in camera settings. Ensure adequate lighting or enable Night Color mode.
Cannot access web interface	Network connectivity issue Firewall blocking access Incorrect credentials	Verify network connection. Check firewall settings on your computer or network. Ensure correct username and password. Reset camera if necessary (refer to factory reset procedure).

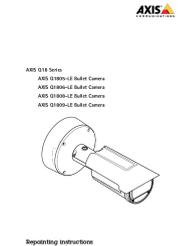
