The built-in Fire TV experience includes a Voice Remote with Alexa, allowing for easy navigation, app launching, content search, input switching, and smart home device control using voice commands. The TV receives automatic over-the-air software updates, ensuring access to the latest Alexa skills and features.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your TOSHIBA TF-43A810U21 package includes the following items:

- TOSHIBA 43-inch 4K UHD Fire TV Edition Television

- Voice Remote with Alexa (requires 2 AAA batteries, included)
- TV Stand (with necessary screws)

SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your new TOSHIBA 4K UHD Fire TV Edition television:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the TV and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Attaching the Stand:** Place the TV face down on a soft, clean surface. Attach the included stand to the bottom of the TV using the provided screws. Ensure the stand is securely fastened.
3. **Connecting Power:** Plug the power cord into the TV's power input, then into a wall outlet.
4. **Connecting Devices:**
 - **Antenna/Cable:** Connect an HD antenna (sold separately) to the ANT/CABLE IN port for live over-the-air TV.
 - **HDMI Devices:** Connect external devices like Blu-ray players, game consoles, or soundbars to the HDMI IN ports. This model includes HDMI 1 (ARC) for audio return channel functionality.
 - **USB Devices:** Use the USB port for media playback or connecting compatible accessories.
 - **Ethernet (LAN):** For a stable internet connection, connect an Ethernet cable to the LAN port.
 - **Audio Out:** Use the Digital Audio Out (Optical) or Audio Out (3.5mm) for external audio systems.

5. **Initial Power On:** Turn on the TV using the power button on the remote or the TV itself.
6. **Remote Pairing:** Insert the included AAA batteries into the Voice Remote. To pair the remote, press and hold the Alexa Voice button (microphone icon) for a few seconds until the TV screen prompts you.
7. **Network Connection:** Follow the on-screen instructions to connect your TV to your Wi-Fi network or confirm the Ethernet connection.
8. **Fire TV Account Setup:** Sign in with your Amazon account to access Fire TV features and content.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your TOSHIBA Fire TV Edition TV is designed for intuitive operation. Here are key functions:

- **Fire TV Home Screen:** The home screen provides access to live TV, streaming apps, and your personalized content. Navigate using the directional pad on your remote.
- **Alexa Voice Remote:**
 - Press and hold the **Alexa Voice button** (microphone icon) to speak commands. You can launch apps, search for titles, switch inputs, and control smart home devices.
 - Dedicated buttons for Prime Video and Netflix provide instant access to these services.

- **Live TV:** If an antenna is connected, access live over-the-air channels directly from the Fire TV home screen.
- **Streaming Apps:** Download and access a wide variety of streaming applications from the Appstore.
- **Input Switching:** Use the input button on the remote or voice command to switch between HDMI inputs, AV, and TV tuner.
- **Settings:** Access TV settings for picture, sound, network, and device preferences through the Fire TV interface.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your television:

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, dry microfiber cloth. For stubborn smudges, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-specific cleaning solution (do not spray directly onto the screen).
- **Cleaning the Cabinet:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the TV cabinet. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Software Updates:** Your TV receives automatic over-the-air software updates. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive these updates, which improve performance and add new features.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the TV. Do not block ventilation openings.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TOSHIBA TF-43A810U21 TV, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Power:**
 - Check if the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and the wall outlet.
 - Verify the wall outlet is functioning by plugging in another device.
- **No Picture/Sound:**
 - Ensure the correct input source is selected (e.g., HDMI 1, TV).
 - Check all cable connections (HDMI, antenna, AV) are secure.
 - If using external devices, ensure they are powered on and functioning correctly.
- **Remote Not Responding:**
 - Replace the batteries in the remote control.
 - Re-pair the remote with the TV by holding the Alexa Voice button for a few seconds.
- **Network Connectivity Issues:**
 - Restart your Wi-Fi router and modem.
 - Go to the TV's network settings and try reconnecting to your Wi-Fi network.
 - If using an Ethernet connection, ensure the cable is securely connected.
- **Picture Quality Issues:**
 - Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, color) in the TV's menu.
 - Ensure the content you are watching is of high quality (e.g., 4K content for 4K resolution).
