Product Overview

Utilizing Quantum Dot technology, it produces rich colors, detailed images, and smooth motion. This TV integrates Android TV for easy access to streaming services and applications.

- **Quantum Dot Technology:** Experience over a billion perfectly expressed colors for incredible, ultra-bright 4K detail.
- **Dolby Vision HDR & Dolby Atmos:** Transform your home into an entertainment powerhouse with cinematic picture and immersive audio.
- **Full Array Local Dimming:** Up to 90 local dimming zones deliver superior HDR with up to 1,000-nits peak brightness.
- **Game Mode:** Significantly improves input lag for optimized gaming.
- **Hand-Free Voice Control:** Control the TV via the voice-enabled remote or an Alexa-enabled device (sold separately).

Setup Instructions

1. Unboxing and Initial Preparation

Carefully remove the TV from its packaging. It is recommended that two people handle the TV due to its size and weight. Ensure you have a flat, stable surface for assembly.

2. Attaching the TV Stand

Locate the two stand legs and the provided screws. Align each stand leg with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV. Secure them firmly with the screws. Ensure the stand is stable before proceeding.

3. Connecting Power and External Devices

Connect the power cable to the TV and a power outlet. Use HDMI cables to connect external devices such as cable boxes, gaming consoles, or Blu-ray players to the HDMI ports on the TV. The TV features multiple HDMI 2.0 ports, with one supporting eARC for enhanced audio return.

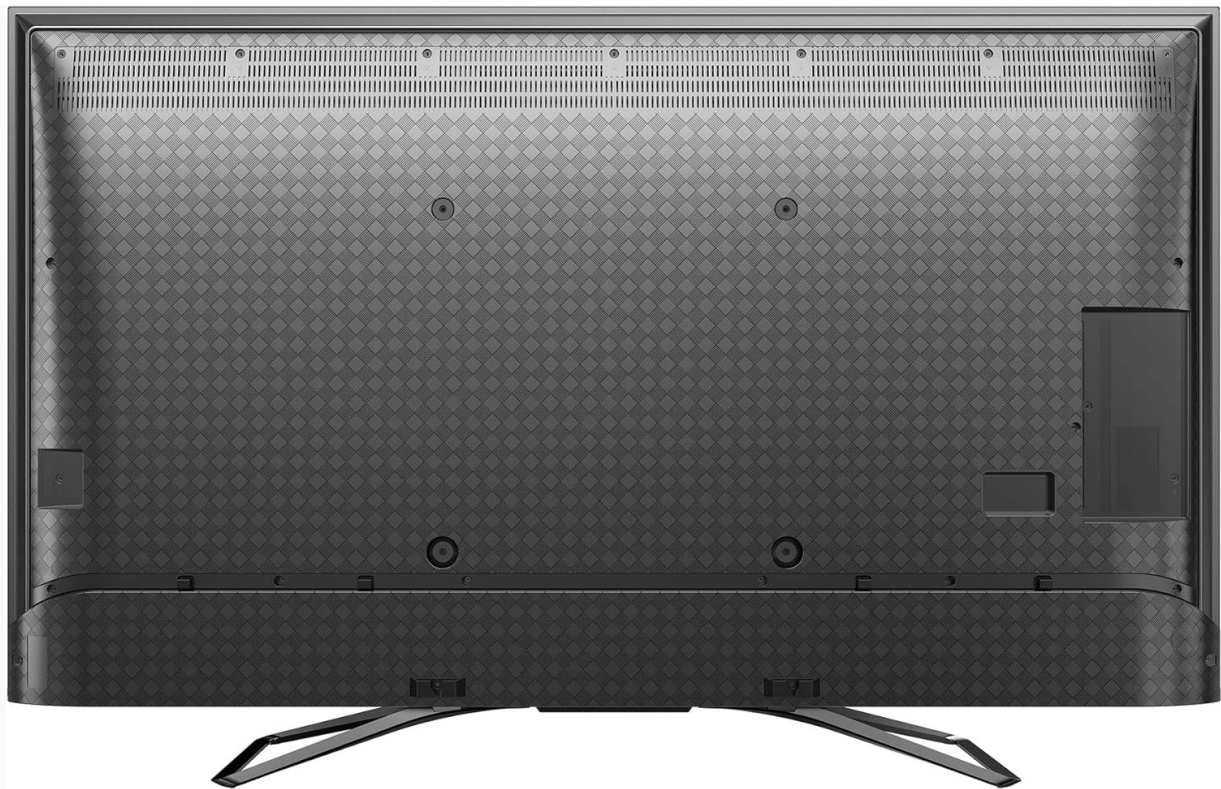


Figure 3: Rear view of the Hisense TV, highlighting the various input ports for connectivity.

4. Initial Setup (Android TV)

Upon first power-on, the TV will guide you through the Android TV setup process. This typically involves connecting to your Wi-Fi network, signing into your Google account, and installing preferred streaming applications. The setup is designed to be user-friendly.

Operating Instructions

1. Remote Control Usage

The included voice-enabled remote allows for easy navigation and control. It features quick access buttons for popular streaming services like Netflix and YouTube, along with standard navigation and volume controls. Voice commands can be used to open apps, control volume, switch inputs, and search for content.

2. Navigating the Android TV Interface

The Android TV interface provides a personalized home screen with recommendations, quick access to installed apps, and live TV options. You can customize the app layout and access settings directly from the home screen. The interface is responsive and integrates well with Apple's ecosystem, supporting HomeKit and AirPlay 2.

3. Picture and Sound Settings

The TV offers various picture modes to optimize viewing for different content types (e.g., Standard, Movie, Game). Adjust brightness, contrast, and color settings to your preference. The built-in 4.2.1 speaker system provides enhanced audio, but external soundbars can be connected for a more immersive experience.

Maintenance

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your TV, try the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the power outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Check all HDMI connections. Ensure the correct input source is selected on the TV.
- **Remote Not Responding:** Replace the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV.

- **Internet Connectivity Issues:** Check your Wi-Fi router and ensure it is working correctly. Restart the TV and the router.
- **Slow Performance:** Restart the TV. Close any unused applications running in the background.


