1. INTRODUCTION

2. HANDLING AND DISPLAY

Proper handling is crucial to preserve the condition and value of your collectible coin. This coin is in Uncirculated (UNC) condition, meaning it has never been used in commerce and retains its original mint luster.

- **Always hold the coin by its edges:** Use clean, lint-free cotton gloves to prevent transferring oils and acids from your skin, which can cause permanent damage or tarnish.
- **Avoid touching the coin's surfaces:** The obverse (front) and reverse (back) surfaces are the most vulnerable to damage from fingerprints.
- **Display considerations:** If displaying, ensure the coin is in a protective holder (e.g., a non-PVC flip, slab, or capsule) to shield it from environmental elements and accidental contact.

3. STORAGE AND CARE

Long-term preservation requires careful storage to protect the coin from environmental degradation.

- **Protective Holders:** Store the coin in inert, archival-safe materials. Avoid soft plastic flips containing PVC (polyvinyl chloride), as these can leach chemicals over time, causing green slime or surface damage. Recommended options include Mylar flips, acrylic capsules, or professional grading slabs.

- **Environment:** Keep the coin in a stable environment, away from extreme temperature fluctuations, high humidity, and direct sunlight. A cool, dry, and dark place is ideal.
- **Cleaning:** Generally, cleaning collectible coins is not recommended. Cleaning can remove original patina, reduce luster, and potentially scratch the surface, significantly decreasing its numismatic value. If cleaning is considered, consult a professional numismatist.

4. COMMON CONCERNS

Understanding potential issues can help in maintaining your coin's condition.

- **Tarnishing:** Coins made of copper-nickel can naturally tarnish over time due to exposure to air and moisture. This is a natural process and often considered part of the coin's character. Aggressive cleaning to remove tarnish is generally discouraged.
- **Scratches or Dings:** These usually result from improper handling or storage. Once a coin is scratched, the damage is permanent. Always handle with care.
- **Environmental Damage:** Exposure to harsh chemicals, smoke, or pollutants can cause irreversible damage to the coin's surface. Ensure storage is in a clean, protected environment.
