1. Introduction

The Scheppach HCE2500 high-pressure cleaner is a powerful and versatile tool designed for various cleaning tasks around your home and garden. With its robust 180 bar maximum pressure and a comprehensive 10-piece accessory set, it provides efficient and effective cleaning for a wide range of surfaces.

Key features include:

- Powerful 180 bar maximum pressure for demanding cleaning tasks.
- Extended working radius with a 5-meter high-pressure hose.
- Integrated holders for nozzles and high-pressure hose for convenient storage.
- Designed for mobile use, easy to transport.
- Durable and reliable aluminum pump for long service life.
- Includes a comprehensive 10-piece accessory set for diverse applications.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe the following safety precautions when operating the high-pressure cleaner to prevent injury or damage.

- Read the entire manual before operating the device.
- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including safety glasses and hearing protection.
- Do not direct the water jet at people, animals, electrical equipment, or the device itself.
- Ensure the power supply matches the specifications on the rating plate.
- Never operate the device with a damaged power cord or high-pressure hose.
- · Keep children and unauthorized persons away from the operating area.
- Disconnect the power plug from the socket before any cleaning, maintenance, or storage.
- Do not use flammable liquids or solvents with the high-pressure cleaner.
- Ensure stable footing when operating the device.

3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS AND ACCESSORIES

The Scheppach HCE2500 comes with a comprehensive set of components and accessories to handle various cleaning tasks.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble and prepare your high-pressure cleaner for first use.

1. Unpacking: Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Check for any damage during transit.

- 2. **Handle Assembly:** Attach the handle to the main unit if it's not pre-assembled. Secure it with the provided screws.
- 3. Wheel Assembly (if applicable): If the wheels are not attached, secure them to the base of the unit.
- 4. **Connect High-Pressure Hose:** Connect one end of the high-pressure hose to the high-pressure outlet on the cleaner unit and the other end to the high-pressure gun. Ensure connections are secure.
- 5. Connect Water Supply: Connect a garden hose (not included) to the water inlet on the cleaner unit. Ensure the water supply has sufficient flow and pressure. It is recommended to use a water filter to prevent debris from entering the pump.
- 6. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a suitable grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the power switch is in the "OFF" position before plugging in.
- 7. **Purge Air:** Before starting the motor, turn on the water supply and squeeze the trigger on the high-pressure gun to allow water to flow through the system and purge any air. Continue until a steady stream of water emerges from the nozzle.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section provides guidance on how to operate your Scheppach HCE2500 high-pressure cleaner effectively and safely.

5.1 Starting the High-Pressure Cleaner

- 1. Ensure the unit is properly set up and connected to water and power.
- 2. Turn on the water supply completely.
- 3. Turn the main power switch on the unit to the "ON" position. The motor will start.
- 4. Point the high-pressure gun at the surface to be cleaned, maintaining a safe distance.
- 5. Squeeze the trigger on the high-pressure gun to begin spraying. The motor will run continuously while the trigger is pressed.

5.2 Using Different Nozzles and Attachments

The HCE2500 includes various nozzles and attachments for different cleaning needs:

- Standard Nozzle: For general cleaning tasks.
- High-Pressure Nozzle: Provides a concentrated, powerful jet for stubborn dirt.
- Surface Cleaner: Ideal for cleaning large flat surfaces like patios and driveways.
- Cleaning Brush / Rotating Wash Brush: For gentle cleaning of sensitive surfaces or for applying detergent.
- Detergent Tank: Fill with appropriate high-pressure cleaner detergent for enhanced cleaning.
- 90° Nozzle: Useful for cleaning hard-to-reach areas or under vehicles.

To change attachments, ensure the unit is off and the water supply is closed. Release any residual pressure by squeezing the trigger. Twist and pull to remove the current attachment, then push and twist to secure the new one.

5.3 Self-Suction Function

The Scheppach HCE2500 is equipped with a self-suction function, allowing it to draw water from an external source like a bucket or water butt, useful when a direct tap connection is not available. Ensure the water source is clean and free of debris.

To use the self-suction function, connect a suitable suction hose (not included) to the water inlet of the cleaner and immerse the other end into your water source. Follow the purging air steps before starting the motor.

6. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your high-pressure cleaner.

6.1 Cleaning

- After each use, disconnect the power and water supply.
- Drain any remaining water from the pump and hoses.
- Clean the exterior of the unit with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh detergents or solvents.
- Check the water inlet filter for debris and clean it if necessary.
- Clear any blockages in the nozzles using the provided nozzle cleaning tool (if included) or a thin wire.

6.2 Storage

- Store the high-pressure cleaner in a frost-free environment to prevent damage to the pump.
- Ensure all water is drained from the unit, hoses, and accessories before storing, especially in cold climates.
- Coil the high-pressure hose and power cord neatly. Utilize the integrated holders on the unit for organized storage.
- Store all accessories in a dry, secure place.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this section for common issues and their potential solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Motor does not start.	No power supply. Power switch is OFF. Thermal overload protection activated.	Check power connection and circuit breaker. Turn power switch to ON. Allow unit to cool down for 15-30 minutes.
No water pressure or low pressure.	Water supply turned off or insufficient. Air in the pump. Clogged water inlet filter. Clogged nozzle. Kinked hose.	Ensure water supply is fully open. Purge air from the system (see Setup). Clean water inlet filter. Clean or replace nozzle. Straighten hose.
Water leaks from connections.	Loose connections. Worn O-rings/seals.	Tighten all connections. Inspect and replace worn O-rings/seals.
Detergent not dispensing.	Detergent tank empty. Detergent nozzle clogged. Incorrect nozzle selected.	Refill detergent tank. Clean detergent nozzle. Ensure appropriate low-pressure nozzle or detergent attachment is used.
