INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Elementi Lunar Bowl Series Natural Gas Fire Pit. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your fire pit. Please read all instructions carefully before installation and use. Keep this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these instructions could result in fire, explosion, or carbon monoxide poisoning, which could cause property damage, personal injury, or death.

- Maintain adequate clearance from combustible materials. Refer to local building codes and fire safety regulations for specific distances.
- Use only approved fuel types (Natural Gas for this model). Do not use any other fuels.
- Ensure proper ventilation when operating the fire pit. Do not use in enclosed spaces.
- This fire pit is designed for outdoor use only.
- Keep children and pets away from the fire pit during operation and while it is cooling down.
- Do not store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance.
- Never leave the fire pit unattended when in use.
- Always turn off the gas supply when the fire pit is not in use.
- Inspect the gas hose and connections for leaks before each use.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present and undamaged before assembly.

- Elementi Lunar Bowl Series Fire Pit (OFG101-NG)
- 13.2 lbs (6 kg) Lava Rocks
- Protective Canvas Cover
- Natural Gas Hose and Regulator (pre-attached or included)
- Instruction Manual

Note: Optional accessories such as a stainless steel lid, propane tank cover, and glass windscreen are sold separately.

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Placement:** Position the fire pit on a flat, stable, non-combustible surface outdoors. Ensure sufficient clearance from walls, ceilings, and other combustible materials.
3. **Gas Connection:** This model is designed for natural gas. Connect the natural gas hose to a fixed outdoor natural gas supply line. Ensure all connections are tight and secure. Use a leak detection solution (soapy water) to check for any gas leaks at connections. Bubbles indicate a leak.
4. **Lava Rock Placement:** Distribute the provided lava rocks evenly over the burner pan. Do not cover the ignition system or burner holes completely, as this can impede proper ignition and flame distribution.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Before Lighting:** Ensure the gas supply valve is open. Check for any obstructions in the burner area.
2. **Ignition:** Turn the control knob to the 'LOW' position and push it in. While holding the knob in, press the electronic igniter button repeatedly until the burner ignites. You should hear a clicking sound.
3. **Flame Adjustment:** Once ignited, continue to hold the control knob in for 10-15 seconds to allow the thermocouple to heat up. Release the knob. If the flame extinguishes, repeat the ignition process. Rotate the control knob to adjust the flame height to your desired level.
4. **Shutting Down:** To turn off the fire pit, rotate the control knob to the 'OFF' position. Close the main gas supply valve. Allow the fire pit to cool completely before covering or moving.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the exterior surfaces with a soft cloth and mild soap solution. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Covering:** Use the provided protective canvas cover when the fire pit is not in use and has cooled down completely. This protects it from weather elements and debris.
- **Burner Inspection:** Periodically inspect the burner and gas connections for any signs of damage, corrosion, or blockages. Clean any debris from the burner ports.
- **Lava Rock Care:** Ensure lava rocks are dry before use. Replace any cracked or deteriorated lava rocks.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fire pit does not ignite.	No gas supply, igniter not sparking, igniter wire disconnected, burner ports blocked.	Check gas supply valve. Ensure igniter wire is securely connected (refer to image of control panel). Clean burner ports. Replace igniter battery if applicable.
Flame is weak or inconsistent.	Low gas pressure, partially blocked burner ports, lava rocks obstructing burner.	Ensure gas supply valve is fully open. Clear burner ports. Redistribute lava rocks to ensure proper gas flow.
Flame goes out after releasing control knob.	Thermocouple not heating sufficiently, faulty thermocouple.	Hold the control knob in for a longer duration (15-20 seconds) after ignition. If problem persists, contact customer support.
Smell of gas.	Gas leak.	Immediately turn off gas supply. Do not attempt to ignite. Use soapy water to check all connections for leaks. If a leak is detected and cannot be resolved, contact a qualified gas technician or emergency services.
