INTRODUCTION

The GE XWFE Refrigerator Water Filter is a genuine replacement filter designed to provide clean, great-tasting water directly from your GE refrigerator. Certified to rigorous NSF/ANSI Drinking Water Treatment standards, this filter significantly reduces a wide range of impurities, ensuring high-quality water for your household. Regular replacement is crucial for maintaining optimal filtration performance and extending the life of your appliance's water system.

- **Pharmaceuticals Reduction:** Effectively reduces select pharmaceuticals such as ibuprofen, progesterone, atenolol, trimethoprim, and fluoxetine. (Note: Impurities are not necessarily found in all users' water.)

- **Six-Month Filter Life:** For optimal filtration results, the filter cartridge should be replaced every six months or after filtering 300 gallons of water. Replace sooner if you notice a significant decline in water flow rate.

1. **Locate Filter Compartment:** Open your refrigerator and locate the water filter compartment. This is typically found in the top right corner of the fresh food section or within the door.
2. **Remove Old Filter:** Gently open the filter cover. Rotate the old filter cartridge counter-clockwise (usually a quarter turn) until it disengages from the housing. Pull the filter straight out. A small amount of water may drip, which is normal.
3. **Prepare New Filter:** Remove the new GE XWFE filter from its packaging. Ensure the protective cap is removed from the end of the filter.
4. **Install New Filter:** Align the new filter with the filter housing. Push the filter firmly into the housing and rotate it clockwise (a quarter turn) until it locks securely into place. You should feel it click.
5. **Close Compartment:** Close the filter compartment cover.
6. **Flush the System:** Dispense approximately 2 gallons of water through the dispenser to flush the system. This removes any air from the lines and carbon fines from the new filter. Discard the first few batches of ice produced after replacement.
7. **Reset Filter Indicator:** If your refrigerator has a filter status indicator light, reset it according to your refrigerator's specific instructions (often by pressing and holding a "Filter Status" or "Reset" button for 3 seconds).

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Slow Water Flow	Clogged filter; Air in system.	Replace filter if due; Flush 2-3 gallons of water to clear air.
Cloudy or Discolored Water	Carbon fines from new filter; Air bubbles.	Flush 2-3 gallons of water until clear. This is normal for new filters.
Filter Status Light Remains Red/Orange	Indicator not reset.	Reset the filter indicator on your refrigerator (refer to your appliance manual for specific instructions).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water Leakage	Filter not properly seated or damaged O-ring.	Remove and re-install filter, ensuring it's securely twisted into place. Check O-rings for damage.
