XVEFAT Replacement Remote Control Instruction Manual

For Onkyo AV Receiver Models: TX-NR676, TX-NR676E, TX-NR686, TX-NR585, TX-RZ720

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your new XVEFAT replacement remote control. This remote is designed to be compatible with various Onkyo AV Receiver models, offering a direct replacement without the need for complex programming.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

The remote control requires two (2) AAA alkaline batteries for operation. Follow these steps to install them:

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
2. Press down on the tab and slide the cover downwards to remove it.
3. Insert two (2) AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align with the markings inside the compartment.
4. Slide the battery compartment cover back into place until it clicks securely.

2. Initial Use

No programming or pairing is required for this replacement remote control. Once batteries are correctly installed, the remote is ready for immediate use with compatible Onkyo AV Receiver models.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Point the remote control directly at your Onkyo AV Receiver. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the receiver's infrared sensor.

Key Functions:

- **Power Button:** Located at the top, typically orange, to turn the receiver on or off.
- **Input Selectors (BD/DVD, CBL/SAT, GAME, STRMBOX, PC, AUX, CD, TV, PHONO, TUNER, NET, Bluetooth):** Use these buttons to switch between different audio/video input sources connected to your receiver.
- **Volume Control (VOL + / -):** Adjusts the master volume level of your receiver.
- **Mute Button:** Silences the audio output.
- **Navigation Pad (Up, Down, Left, Right, ENTER):** Used for navigating menus and confirming selections on your receiver's display.
- **Quick Menu (Q):** Accesses quick settings or on-screen menus.
- **Return/Back Button:** Returns to the previous menu or screen.
- **Setup Button:** Accesses the main setup menu of the receiver.
- **Playback Controls (Play/Pause, Stop, Fast Forward, Rewind, Skip):** Controls media playback for connected devices.
- **Sound Modes (MOVIE/TV, MUSIC, GAME):** Selects different audio processing modes optimized for various content types.
- **Zone 2:** Controls audio in a secondary listening zone, if supported by your receiver.

MAINTENANCE

Battery Replacement:

Replace batteries when the remote control's response becomes sluggish or stops functioning. Always replace both batteries simultaneously with new AAA alkaline batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.

Cleaning:

To clean the remote control, wipe it gently with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners, abrasive pads, or chemical solvents, as these may damage the remote's surface or internal components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Remote not responding:**
 - Ensure batteries are installed correctly with the correct polarity.
 - Replace old batteries with new AAA alkaline batteries.
 - Check for any obstructions between the remote control and the AV receiver's infrared sensor.
 - Ensure you are within the effective operating range and pointing the remote directly at the receiver.
- **Specific functions not working:**
 - Verify that your AV receiver model is listed as compatible with this remote control.
 - Some advanced functions or specific menu options might require the original receiver remote or direct control from the receiver itself.
