- This product contains batteries that are not replaceable.



SETUP

- 1. **Initial Charge:** Place the toothbrush handle on the magnetic charging stand. The display will show the battery level. A full charge typically takes approximately 3 hours.
- 2. **Attach Brush Head:** Align the brush head with the shaft on the toothbrush handle and push it down until it clicks into place.
- 3. **Download Oral-B App (Optional but Recommended):** For enhanced features like AI recognition and real-time tracking, download the Oral-B app from your device's app store and follow the in-app instructions to pair your toothbrush via Bluetooth.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Powering On/Off and Mode Selection

- 1. **Power On:** Press the power button () to turn on the toothbrush.
- 2. **Select Mode:** Use the mode button (●) to cycle through the available cleaning modes. The iO Series 7G offers 5 modes:
 - Daily Clean
 - Sensitive
 - Intense
 - Whitening
 - Gum Care
- 3. Start Brushing: Once your desired mode is selected, press the power button again to begin brushing.
- 4. Power Off: Press and hold the power button to turn off the toothbrush.



Smart Pressure Sensor

The toothbrush features an intelligent pressure sensor that provides real-time feedback to protect your gums and enamel:

- Green Light: Indicates optimal brushing pressure.
- Red Light: Signals that you are brushing too hard. Reduce pressure immediately.
- Other Colors (e.g., Orange/White): Suggests insufficient pressure. Apply slightly more pressure for an effective clean.

2-Minute Timer and Quadrant Pacer

The iO Series 7G includes a built-in 2-minute timer to ensure you brush for the dentist-recommended duration. It also features a quadrant pacer that pulsates every 30 seconds, prompting you to move to the next section of your mouth for a thorough clean.

Connect your iO Series 7G to the Oral-B app via Bluetooth for an enhanced brushing experience. The app provides:

- Real-time Al Recognition: Tracks how and where you brush in real-time, guiding you to cover all areas of your mouth.
- Session Score: Provides a score for each brushing session based on coverage, brush time, and pressure.
- Personalized Guidance: Offers insights and recommendations to improve your brushing habits.
- Brush Head Replacement Reminders: Alerts you when it's time to replace your brush head for optimal performance.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Toothbrush

- After each use, rinse the brush head thoroughly under running water with the handle switched on.
- Remove the brush head and clean both the handle and the brush head separately under running water.
- Wipe the handle dry with a soft cloth.
- Clean the charging stand regularly with a damp cloth. Ensure it is unplugged before cleaning.

Replacing Brush Heads

Dentists recommend replacing your brush head every 3 months, or sooner if the bristles are splayed or worn. The Oral-B iO Series 7G uses specific Oral-B iO Ultimate Clean replacement brush heads. Other Oral-B brush heads are not compatible.

Battery Care

To maintain battery life, avoid leaving the toothbrush on the charger continuously when not in use. Charge it when the battery indicator shows a low level.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Toothbrush does not turn on.	Battery may be depleted. Place on charger for at least 30 minutes. Ensure charger is plugged in correctly.
Battery does not hold charge for long.	Battery performance can decrease over time. Ensure full charges are completed. Avoid continuous charging when not in use.
Pressure sensor light is always red.	You may be applying too much pressure. Adjust your brushing technique to maintain a green light.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Oral-B App not connecting or tracking correctly.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and the app is open during brushing. Restart the app and/or toothbrush. Check for app updates.
Brush head feels loose.	Ensure the brush head is fully pushed down onto the shaft until it clicks. If it remains loose, the brush head may be worn or damaged and needs replacement.
