2. SETUP

2.1 Package Contents

- Ascended Cord (attached)
- Quick Start Guide (this document)

- 2. Plug the USB connector of the Glorious Model O- (Minus) into the USB port.
- 3. The mouse is plug-and-play and should be recognized automatically by your operating system.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Basic Mouse Functions

- Left Click: Primary action button.
- Right Click: Secondary action button, typically for context menus.
- Scroll Wheel: Scrolls content up/down. Can also be clicked for middle-click functionality.
- Side Buttons: Programmable buttons, typically for forward/back navigation in browsers or in-game actions.

3.2 DPI Adjustment

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning the Mouse

- Ensure the mouse is disconnected from your computer before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the surface of the mouse.
- For the optical sensor, use a cotton swab lightly dampened with isopropyl alcohol to gently clean the lens.

Avoid excessive moisture.

• Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the mouse's finish or internal components.

4.2 Cable Care

The Ascended Cord is designed to be lightweight and flexible. Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the cable to prevent damage. Use a cable tie or management system to keep the cable tidy and prevent tangles.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Mouse Not Responding

- Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer.
- Try plugging the mouse into a different USB port.
- · Restart your computer.
- Test the mouse on another computer to determine if the issue is with the mouse or your system.

5.2 Inconsistent Tracking or Cursor Movement

- Clean the optical sensor as described in the Maintenance section.
- Ensure you are using the mouse on a clean, uniform surface (e.g., a mouse pad). Avoid highly reflective or transparent surfaces.
- Check DPI settings using the DPI button or Glorious Core software.
- Update your mouse drivers or Glorious Core software to the latest version.

5.3 RGB Lighting Not Working Correctly

- Ensure Glorious Core software is installed and up to date.
- · Check the lighting settings within Glorious Core to ensure RGB is enabled and configured as desired.
- · Restart your computer.
