1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your new TOP VACUUM PARTS Replacement Clean Tank with Cap. This part is designed to restore the functionality of your Bissell Spot Clean Vacuum Cleaner by replacing a damaged or worn clean water tank. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure proper function and longevity of the product.

2. PRODUCT COMPATIBILITY

Important: Please verify your vacuum cleaner's model number before installation. This replacement part is specifically designed for the models listed below. Do not attempt to install if your model is not listed, as it may not fit correctly.

This replacement clean tank (compare to part number 1600027) is compatible with the following Bissell Spot Clean Vacuum Cleaner models:

- Bissell Spot Clean Model 5207
- Bissell Spot Clean Model 7786
- Bissell Spot Clean Model 9749

4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to replace the clean tank on your Bissell Spot Clean Vacuum Cleaner:

1. **Preparation:** Ensure the vacuum cleaner is unplugged from the power outlet before beginning any maintenance or part replacement.
2. **Remove Old Tank:** Locate the clean water tank on your Bissell Spot Clean unit. Depending on your model, it typically detaches by lifting it straight up or by pressing a release button and then lifting.
3. **Inspect Area:** Briefly inspect the area where the tank sits for any debris or residue and clean if necessary.
4. **Install New Tank:** Take your new TOP VACUUM PARTS Replacement Clean Tank. Align the bottom of the tank with the corresponding slot or base on the vacuum cleaner. Gently push down until it clicks securely into place. Ensure it is seated firmly and does not wobble.
5. **Fill Tank:** Once installed, you can fill the clean tank with the appropriate cleaning solution and water as per your vacuum cleaner's original instructions. Ensure the cap is securely fastened.
6. **Test:** Plug in your vacuum cleaner and perform a brief test to ensure the tank is properly installed and there are no leaks.

5. OPERATION

Once the replacement clean tank is securely installed and filled with the appropriate cleaning solution, operate your Bissell Spot Clean Vacuum Cleaner as you normally would. The new tank functions identically to the original, providing a reservoir for your clean water and cleaning formula.

- Always use cleaning solutions recommended by Bissell or compatible with your specific Spot Clean model.

- Do not overfill the tank beyond the indicated maximum fill line.
- Ensure the tank cap is tightly sealed to prevent leaks during operation.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance of your clean tank will ensure its longevity and the efficient operation of your vacuum cleaner:

- **Empty After Each Use:** Always empty any remaining cleaning solution from the clean tank after each use. Do not store solution in the tank for extended periods.
- **Rinse Thoroughly:** Rinse the inside of the clean tank with warm water after emptying. This helps prevent residue buildup and odors.
- **Clean Cap and Seal:** Periodically check the tank cap and its rubber seal for any debris or damage. Clean the seal if necessary to ensure a tight fit and prevent leaks.
- **Air Dry:** Allow the tank to air dry completely before reattaching it to the vacuum cleaner or storing it.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals on the tank, as this may damage the plastic.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your replacement clean tank, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tank is leaking	Cap not sealed properly; damaged seal; tank not seated correctly.	Ensure cap is tightly closed. Check rubber seal for damage or debris and clean. Re-seat the tank firmly into the vacuum cleaner.
Tank does not fit	Incorrect model number; tank not aligned properly.	Verify your vacuum cleaner's model number against the compatible models listed in Section 2. Ensure the tank is aligned correctly before pushing down to seat it.
No solution dispensing	Tank empty; cap not properly vented (if applicable); internal vacuum issue.	Refill the tank. Check the cap for proper sealing and ensure any air vents are clear. If the issue persists, consult your vacuum cleaner's main manual for troubleshooting dispensing problems.
