Mera Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION AND SAFETY INFORMATION

Thank you for choosing the Mera Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed. This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bed. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

Important Safety Warnings:

- Do not exceed the weight limits: **Upper bunk: 175 lbs; Lower bunk: 275 lbs.**
- Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened before use and check periodically.
- The upper bunk is not suitable for children under six years of age.
- Use only mattresses that comply with the recommended thickness to ensure guardrail effectiveness.
- Never allow horseplay on or under the bed.
- Always use the ladder for entering and exiting the upper bunk.

2. COMPONENTS AND HARDWARE

Your Mera Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed comes in two packages, including all necessary parts and hardware for assembly. Please verify that all components are present and undamaged before starting. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of this bunk bed requires careful attention to detail. We recommend two adults for efficient and safe assembly. An electric drill may be helpful for speeding up the process, but ensure not to overtighten screws.

General Assembly Steps:

1. Unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
2. Identify all parts using the provided diagram.
3. Begin by assembling the main frame sections according to the step-by-step instructions.
4. Attach the bed slats to both the upper and lower bunks. Ensure they are evenly spaced and securely fastened.
5. Install the guardrails on the upper bunk. These are crucial safety features.
6. Attach the built-in ladder securely to the bed frame.
7. Finally, assemble the roof and window sections of the house frame.
8. Once assembled, double-check all connections and fasteners to ensure they are tight and secure.

- **Guardrails:** The full-length guardrails on the upper bunk are designed to prevent accidental falls. Ensure they are always in place and secure.
- **Ladder:** Use the built-in 3-step ladder for safe access to and from the upper bunk.
- **Playhouse Feature:** The pitched roof and window section create a unique play area. Ensure children use this feature safely and responsibly.
