This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Fette Filter HEPA vacuum air filters. Adhering to these instructions will help ensure optimal performance and longevity of the filters, contributing to a cleaner home environment.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

These Fette Filter HEPA vacuum air filters are designed for use with Electrolux Guardian, LUX, and Aerus Epic 8000/9000 series vacuum cleaners. They provide enhanced filtration to capture dust, pet dander, and other airborne particles, contributing to cleaner indoor air. This product is not manufactured by Electrolux or Frigidaire PureAdvantage; brand names are used solely for compatibility reference.

The filters are a precise match for models C134A, C134B, C134C, C134D, C134E, C134F, C154A, C154B, C154C, and C154D, ensuring optimal performance and easy replacement. Each pack contains two filters.

3. INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to replace your vacuum's HEPA filter:

1. **Prepare the Vacuum:** Ensure the vacuum cleaner is turned off and unplugged from the power outlet before beginning any maintenance.
2. **Locate Filter Compartment:** Identify the filter compartment on your vacuum. This is typically located near the motor or the dustbin. Refer to your vacuum cleaner's original manual for exact location if unsure.
3. **Remove Old Filter:** Open the filter compartment. Carefully remove the old, used filter. Dispose of the old filter according to local regulations.
4. **Insert New Filter:** Place the new Fette Filter HEPA filter into the compartment. Ensure it is seated correctly and fits snugly to create a proper seal.
5. **Secure Compartment:** Close the filter compartment securely. A proper seal is crucial for effective filtration and to prevent dust leakage.
6. **Resume Operation:** Plug in the vacuum cleaner and power it on. The vacuum is now ready for use with the new filter.

4. OPERATION

Once the Fette Filter HEPA filter is correctly installed, it operates automatically as part of your vacuum cleaner's filtration system. The filter continuously works to trap fine particles, allergens, and dust from the air expelled by the vacuum, contributing to a cleaner and healthier indoor environment. Ensure the filter compartment is always securely closed before operating the vacuum to maintain optimal performance and prevent damage.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular filter maintenance is essential for maintaining your vacuum's suction power and air filtration efficiency.

- **Replacement Frequency:** It is recommended to replace the HEPA filter every 6 to 12 months. This frequency may vary based on usage intensity, the presence of pets, and household dust levels.
- **Signs of Replacement:** Replace the filter if you notice a significant decrease in suction power, an increase in dust escaping the vacuum exhaust, or persistent unusual odors during operation.
- **Cleaning:** While some filters are washable, HEPA filters are generally designed for optimal performance when dry. Refer to your vacuum's original manual or the filter's packaging for specific cleaning instructions. If the filter is marked as "Reusable" (as per product specifications), it typically refers to the filter's lifespan before replacement, not washability, unless explicitly stated by the manufacturer. Avoid washing HEPA filters unless explicitly stated by the manufacturer, as this can damage the filter media and reduce its effectiveness.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues related to your vacuum's performance after filter installation, consider the following:

- **Reduced Suction Power:**
 - Check if the filter is clogged with excessive debris. Replace if heavily soiled.
 - Ensure the filter is installed correctly and seated firmly in its compartment, creating a tight seal.
 - Verify that other parts of the vacuum (hoses, bags, nozzles) are not clogged.
- **Unusual Odors from Vacuum:**
 - A dirty or old filter can cause odors. Replace the filter.
 - Ensure the vacuum bag (if applicable) is not full or emitting odors.
- **Dust Escaping from Exhaust:**
 - Confirm the filter is properly installed and the filter compartment is securely closed.
 - Inspect the filter for any visible damage or tears. Replace if damaged.
