4. SETUP GUIDE

4.1. Battery Installation

The Angrox remote control requires two (2) AAA batteries for operation. Batteries are not included and must be purchased separately.

- 1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
- 2. Slide the cover downwards or press the latch (if present) to open the compartment.
- 3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
- 4. Slide the battery compartment cover back into place until it clicks securely.





Power (Red Button)	Turns the TV on and off.
LIST	Accesses the saved channels list.
VOL+ / VOL-	Adjusts the volume up or down.
CH+ / CH-	Changes channels up or down.
FAV	Accesses your favorite channel list.
MUTE	Cuts off the sound temporarily.

Button	Function
Netflix (N Button)	Directly accesses the Netflix online service.
Amazon (P Button)	Directly accesses the Amazon Prime Video service.
BACK	Returns to the previous step or menu.
EXIT	Exits the current menu or application.
SLEEP	Accesses the sleep timer function.
Color Buttons (Yellow/Blue/Red/Green)	Perform various functions depending on the TV menu or application.
Navigation Pad (Up/Down/Left/Right/OK)	Navigates through menus and confirms selections.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Angrox remote control, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the remote control. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or it stops functioning. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new ones of the same type (AAA).
- Storage: Store the remote in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- Avoid Drops: While durable, repeated drops can damage internal components. Handle the remote with care.
- Liquid Exposure: Keep the remote away from liquids. If liquid spills on the remote, remove batteries immediately and allow it to dry completely before reinserting them.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your remote control, try the following troubleshooting steps:

1. Remote Not Responding:

- Check if the batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity (+/-).
- Replace old batteries with new AAA batteries.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote control and the TV's infrared receiver.
- o Confirm you are within the effective operating range and have a clear line of sight to the TV.

2. Specific Buttons Not Working:

- Clean the remote control, especially around the non-functioning buttons, to remove any dirt or debris that might be
 preventing proper contact.
- Test other buttons to determine if the issue is isolated to specific buttons or the entire remote.

3. Intermittent Functionality:

- This could indicate low battery power. Replace the batteries.
- Ensure no strong light sources (like direct sunlight or bright fluorescent lights) are interfering with the infrared signal.

4. Remote Does Not Control TV:

Verify that your TV model is listed as compatible with this remote control. While universal for many LG models,
 specific older or newer models might have different IR codes.
