INTRODUCTION

The Supkitdin SU-KS Electronic Kitchen Scale is designed for precise measurement of ingredients in your kitchen. Featuring a durable stainless steel platform, a clear LCD display, and multiple unit options, this scale is suitable for various cooking and baking needs. Its compact design allows for easy storage.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 1 x Supkitdin SU-KS Digital Kitchen Scale
- 1 x Silicone Drain Pad

- 2 x AAA 1.5V DC Batteries

SETUP

1. **Unpack the Scale:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Remove Protective Film:** Before first use, detach the blue protective film from the stainless steel weighing platform.
3. **Install Batteries:** Open the battery compartment on the underside of the scale. Insert the two AAA 1.5V DC batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the compartment securely.
4. **Placement:** Always use the scale on a hard, flat, and stable surface. Avoid soft, uneven, or vibrating surfaces to ensure accurate measurements.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

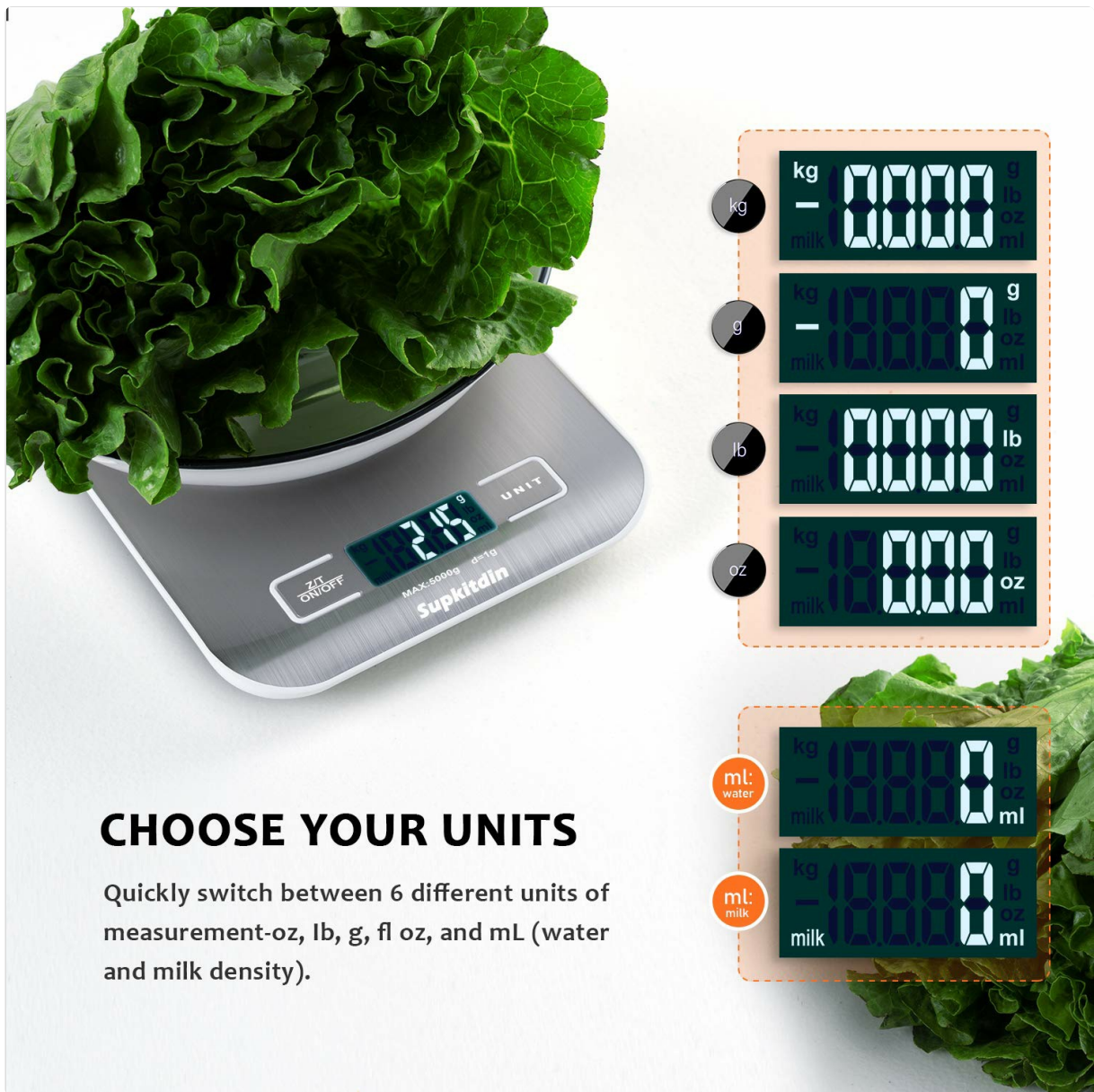
1. Power On/Off

- To turn the scale **ON**, press the **ON/OFF** button briefly. The LCD display will light up and show "0".
- To turn the scale **OFF**, press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for a few seconds until the display turns off. The scale will also automatically shut off after a period of inactivity to conserve battery life.

2. Unit Conversion

The scale supports multiple units of measurement. You can switch between them by pressing the **UNIT** button.

- Available units include: grams (g), pounds (lb), ounces (oz), kilograms (kg), milliliters (ml for water), and milliliters (ml for milk).
- Press the **UNIT** button repeatedly to cycle through the available units until your desired unit is displayed.



CHOOSE YOUR UNITS

Quickly switch between 6 different units of measurement-oz, lb, g, fl oz, and mL (water and milk density).

3. Tare Function

The tare function allows you to subtract the weight of a container or previously added ingredients, enabling you to measure subsequent items accurately.

1. Place an empty container (e.g., a bowl or plate) on the weighing platform. The display will show its weight.
2. Press the **Z/T** button. The display will reset to "0", effectively subtracting the container's weight.
3. Add the ingredients you wish to weigh into the container. The display will now show only the net weight of the ingredients.
4. You can repeat the tare process multiple times to measure different ingredients in the same container.



TARE FUNCTION

Make any container in your home a measuring tool without its added weight.



1 Put the container on the scale.

2 Press the "Z/T" button to zero.

3 Put the food in the container.

4. LCD Display and Buttons Overview



Easily read all of your measurements on a clear large LCD display.

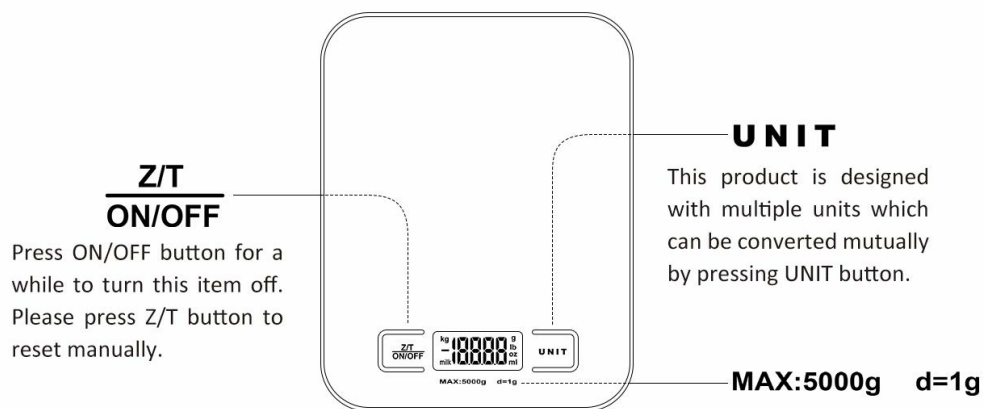


Image: Detailed view of the scale's LCD display and control buttons.

- **LCD Display:** Provides clear, backlit readings of measurements.
- **ON/OFF Button:** Press briefly to turn on, press and hold to turn off.
- **Z/T Button:** Used for the tare function to zero out the weight of containers.
- **UNIT Button:** Cycles through different units of measurement (g, lb, oz, kg, ml water, ml milk).

MAINTENANCE

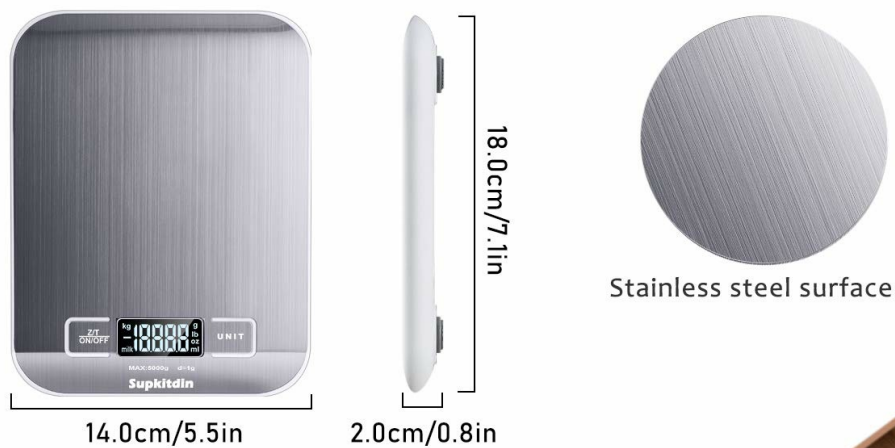
- **Cleaning:** The stainless steel platform is easy to clean. Wipe the scale with a damp cloth after each use. Do not immerse the entire scale body in water, as it is not fully waterproof.
- **Storage:** Store the scale in a dry place, such as a cabinet or drawer. Its slim design allows for convenient storage without taking up excessive space.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace the batteries when the display shows a "LO" indicator, which signifies low battery power.

EASY TO CLEAN

The brushed stainless steel finish makes our scale professional and practical. It's easy to clean, you can clean it with a damp cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Scale does not turn on	Dead or incorrectly installed batteries.	Check battery polarity. Replace batteries if necessary.
"LO" displayed on screen	Low battery power.	Replace both AAA batteries.
Inaccurate readings	Scale not on a flat, stable surface; overloaded; or external interference.	Ensure scale is on a hard, flat surface. Do not exceed maximum capacity (5kg/11lb). Avoid strong electromagnetic fields.
Display shows "O-Ld"	Overload indication.	Remove items from the scale immediately to prevent damage.
