INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Timex 44 mm Essex Ave watch. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your timepiece. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

KEY FEATURES

- Adjustable tan 22mm genuine leather strap, designed to fit wrist circumferences up to 8 inches.
- Black dial with clear partial Arabic numerals for easy time reading.
- Integrated day and date window located at the 3 o'clock position.
- Durable silver-tone octagonal 44mm low lead brass case, protected by a mineral glass crystal.
- Water resistant up to 50 meters (165 feet), suitable for short periods of recreational swimming. Not recommended for diving or snorkeling.

SETUP AND TIME/DATE ADJUSTMENT

Your Timex Essex Ave watch features a quartz movement with day and date functions.

1. Setting the Time:

- Pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) out to position 2.
- Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the correct time. Ensure the AM/PM is correctly set by observing the date change. If the date changes at noon, you are in the PM cycle.
- Once the time is set, push the crown back into position 1 (normal operating position).

2. Setting the Date and Day:

- Pull the crown out to position 1 (the first click).
- Turn the crown clockwise to adjust the date.
- Turn the crown counter-clockwise to adjust the day.
- Avoid setting the date and day between 9:00 PM and 3:00 AM, as this is when the watch's internal mechanism is

engaged in changing the date, and manual adjustment can cause damage.

- Once the date and day are set, push the crown back into position 0 (fully pushed in).

OPERATING YOUR WATCH

Water Resistance

Your Timex Essex Ave watch is water resistant to 50 meters (165 feet). This means it is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming.

- **Rain Resistant:** Yes
- **Light Swimming:** Yes
- **Snorkeling:** No
- **Poolside Diving:** No
- **Surfing:** No
- **Recreational Scuba Diving:** No

Important: To maintain water resistance, do not press any buttons or pull the crown while the watch is submerged in water. Ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any contact with water.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth. For the leather strap, avoid prolonged exposure to water and harsh chemicals. Clean with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary, then dry thoroughly.
- **Strap Care:** The genuine leather strap may show signs of wear over time. Avoid bending or creasing the strap excessively to prolong its life.
- **Battery Replacement:** When the watch stops or the second hand begins to jump erratically (indicating a low battery), have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician.
- **Temperature Extremes:** Avoid exposing your watch to extreme temperatures (hot or cold) for extended periods, as this can affect battery life and movement accuracy.

- **Magnetic Fields:** Keep your watch away from strong magnetic fields, which can interfere with the quartz movement.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Ticking:**

If the watch is not ticking, check if the crown is fully pushed in. If it is, the battery may need replacement. Contact a qualified watch technician for battery service.

- **Date/Day Not Changing:**

Ensure the time is set correctly, especially the AM/PM cycle. If the date/day changes at noon, adjust the time by 12 hours. Avoid manual adjustment between 9 PM and 3 AM.

- **Condensation Under Crystal:**

Small amounts of condensation may appear under the crystal if the watch experiences a sudden temperature change. This usually dissipates quickly. If condensation persists or appears as large droplets, the watch's water resistance may be compromised. Seek professional service immediately.




