EuropAce EPU 3300T Air Purifier User Manual

1. Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your EuropAce EPU 3300T Air Purifier. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and retain it for future reference.

The EuropAce EPU 3300T Air Purifier features a 6-step air purification system designed to improve indoor air quality. Key features include:

- 6-Step Air Purification: Pre-Filter, KOREAN H11 HEPA Filter, Activated Carbon Filter, TiO2, UV Lamp, and loniser.
- Maximum Coverage: Up to 30m2.
- Air Quality Display/Sensor: Provides real-time air quality feedback.
- UV Lamp: Designed to eliminate bacteria, viruses, and germs.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, always follow basic safety precautions when operating this appliance.

- Read all instructions before using the air purifier.
- Ensure the power supply matches the voltage specified on the rating label.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Keep the power cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not immerse the air purifier in water or other liquids.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- · This appliance is for indoor use only.
- · Do not block air inlets or outlets.
- · Keep out of reach of children.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components and control panel of your EuropAce EPU 3300T Air Purifier.

Control Panel Functions:

- Power Button: Turns the unit on or off.
- **Speed/Auto Mode:** Adjusts fan speed (Low, Med, High) or activates Auto mode for automatic speed adjustment based on air quality.
- Timer: Sets operation duration (e.g., 2H, 4H, 8H) after which the unit will automatically shut off.
- Filter Reset: Indicator light illuminates when filter replacement is due. Press and hold to reset after changing filters.
- Sleep Mode: Reduces fan speed and dims indicator lights for quiet operation.
- UV-C/Ion: Activates or deactivates the UV lamp and Ioniser functions.
- Air Quality Indicator: Displays current air quality status (e.g., Clean, Med, Dirty) via color or text.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Unpacking: Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging. Retain packaging materials for future transport or

storage.

2. Filter Installation:

- Open the filter cover, typically located on the back or side of the unit.
- Remove any plastic packaging from the filters.
- Insert the filters into the designated slots, ensuring correct orientation.
- Close the filter cover securely.
- 3. **Placement:** Place the air purifier on a firm, level surface. Ensure there is adequate space (at least 20 cm) around the air inlets and outlets for optimal airflow. Avoid placing near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- 4. Power Connection: Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

Press the **Power** button once to turn the air purifier on. The unit will start in Auto mode or the last used setting. Press the **Power** button again to turn it off.

5.2 Fan Speed and Auto Mode

Press the **Speed/Auto** button repeatedly to cycle through fan speeds: Low, Medium, High. Pressing it again will activate Auto mode. In Auto mode, the fan speed adjusts automatically based on the detected air quality.

5.3 Timer Function

Press the **Timer** button to set the operating duration. Options typically include 2 hours, 4 hours, and 8 hours. The unit will automatically shut off after the selected time has elapsed.

5.4 Sleep Mode

Activate **Sleep Mode** for quieter operation during rest periods. In this mode, the fan speed is reduced, and indicator lights may dim or turn off.

5.5 UV Lamp and Ioniser

Press the **UV-C/Ion** button to activate or deactivate the UV lamp and Ioniser functions. These features enhance air purification by targeting bacteria, viruses, and airborne particles.

5.6 Air Quality Indicator

The air quality display provides visual feedback on the current air purity level. This indicator typically changes color or displays a status (e.g., Clean, Medium, Dirty) based on sensor readings.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your air purifier. Always unplug the unit before cleaning or performing maintenance.

6.1 Cleaning the Exterior

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals.
- Ensure no water enters the air outlets or control panel.

6.2 Filter Replacement

The filter replacement indicator will illuminate when it's time to replace the filters. Filter lifespan varies depending on usage and air quality, typically every 6-12 months.

- 1. Unplug the air purifier.
- 2. Open the filter cover.
- 3. Remove the old filters and dispose of them properly.
- 4. Install new filters, ensuring they are correctly seated and the plastic packaging is removed.
- 5. Close the filter cover.
- 6. Plug in the unit and press and hold the Filter Reset button for a few seconds until the indicator light turns off.

Note: The EuropAce EPU 3300T uses a multi-layer filter system including a Pre-Filter, H11 HEPA, and Activated Carbon Filter. Ensure you replace all components of the filter system as recommended by the manufacturer.

6.3 UV Lamp Replacement

The UV lamp has a limited lifespan. If the UV function is no longer effective, the lamp may need replacement. Refer to the manufacturer's guidelines for specific replacement procedures and compatible UV lamp models.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer support, please refer to the following troubleshooting guide for common issues.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	No power supply. Power cord not properly connected.	Check if the power plug is securely inserted into the outlet. Ensure the power outlet is functional.
Weak airflow.	Filters are dirty or clogged. Air inlets/outlets are blocked.	Replace filters if the filter indicator is on or if they appear visibly dirty. Clear any obstructions from air inlets and outlets.
Unusual noise.	Foreign object inside. Unit not on a level surface.	Unplug and check for any foreign objects. Place the unit on a stable, flat surface.
Air quality indicator always shows "Dirty".	High level of pollutants in the environment. Sensor is dirty.	Allow more time for purification. Clean the air quality sensor (refer to maintenance section for sensor cleaning if applicable, or general cleaning).
Filter reset light remains on after filter change.	Filter reset button not pressed correctly.	After replacing filters, press and hold the Filter Reset button for several seconds until the light turns off.
