1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Delta Chrome Metal Glass Rinser, Model GR250. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure proper function and longevity of the product.

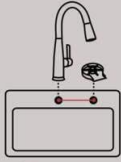
4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Delta Glass Rinser is designed for a simple DIY installation, typically replacing an existing soap dispenser, kitchen sprayer, or sink hole cover.

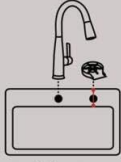
4.1 Pre-Installation Requirements

- **Countertop Hole:** Requires an empty countertop hole.
- **Clearance:**
 - At least 2 inches between faucet and installation hole.
 - At least 4 inches between sink and backsplash.
 - No more than 2 1/4 inches from installation hole to sink.
- **Deck Thickness:** Maximum 2.5 inches.
- **Water Supply:** Connects to either hot or cold water using the included supply line and tee adapter.

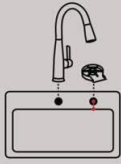

At least 2" between faucet and installation hole

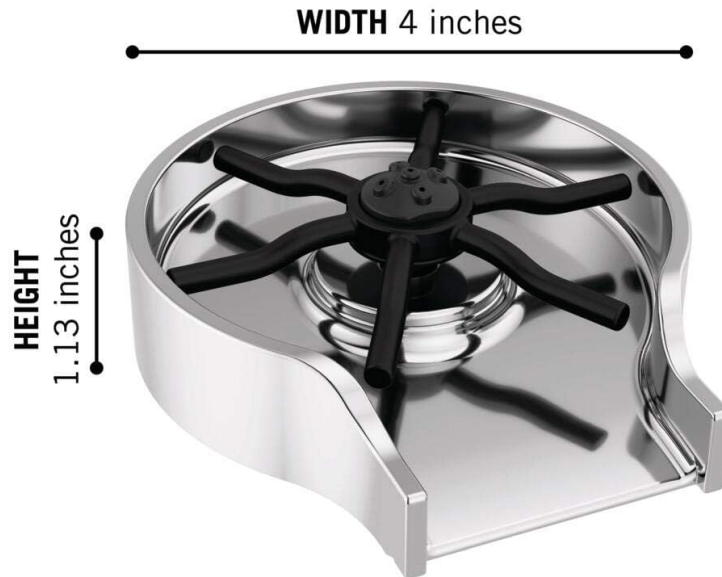


At least 4" between sink and backsplash

4.2 Installation Steps

- 1. Prepare the Hole:** If replacing an existing fixture (soap dispenser, sprayer, or hole cover), remove it. Ensure the countertop hole is clean and clear.
- 2. Mount the Rinser:** Insert the glass rinser unit into the prepared hole. Secure it from underneath the countertop using the provided hardware.
- 3. Connect Water Supply:**
 - Turn off the main water supply to your sink.
 - Locate the hot or cold water supply line under your sink.
 - Install the included tee adapter onto the chosen water supply line.
 - Connect the included supply line from the glass rinser to the tee adapter.
 - Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.
- 4. Test for Leaks:** Slowly turn the main water supply back on and check all connections for any leaks. Tighten if necessary.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Delta Glass Rinser is designed for efficient and thorough rinsing of various drinkware.

1. **Position Drinkware:** Place the mouth of the glass, bottle, or cup face down over the rinser's star-shaped base.
2. **Activate Rinser:** Gently press down on the drinkware. This action activates powerful water jets that spray upwards, thoroughly rinsing the interior of the item.
3. **Rinse Residue:** The high-pressure water jets effectively remove residue from hard-to-reach areas. The subtle overhang of the rinser directs the water flow directly into the kitchen sink for easy cleanup.
4. **Release:** Lift the drinkware off the rinser to stop the water flow.

- **Corrosion Resistance:** The Brilliance finish is engineered for durability and tested for corrosion resistance to at least 2 times industry standards.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Delta Glass Rinser, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No water flow or weak spray.	Water supply is off, supply line kinked, or nozzles are clogged.	Ensure water supply is on. Check for kinks in the supply line. Clean any debris from the sprayer nozzles.
Leaks at connections.	Loose connections or damaged seals.	Turn off water supply. Tighten all connections. Inspect and replace seals if damaged.
Water does not drain properly into the sink.	Rinser not positioned correctly or drain path is obstructed.	Ensure the rinser's overhang is correctly positioned over the sink. Check for any obstructions in the drain path.
