

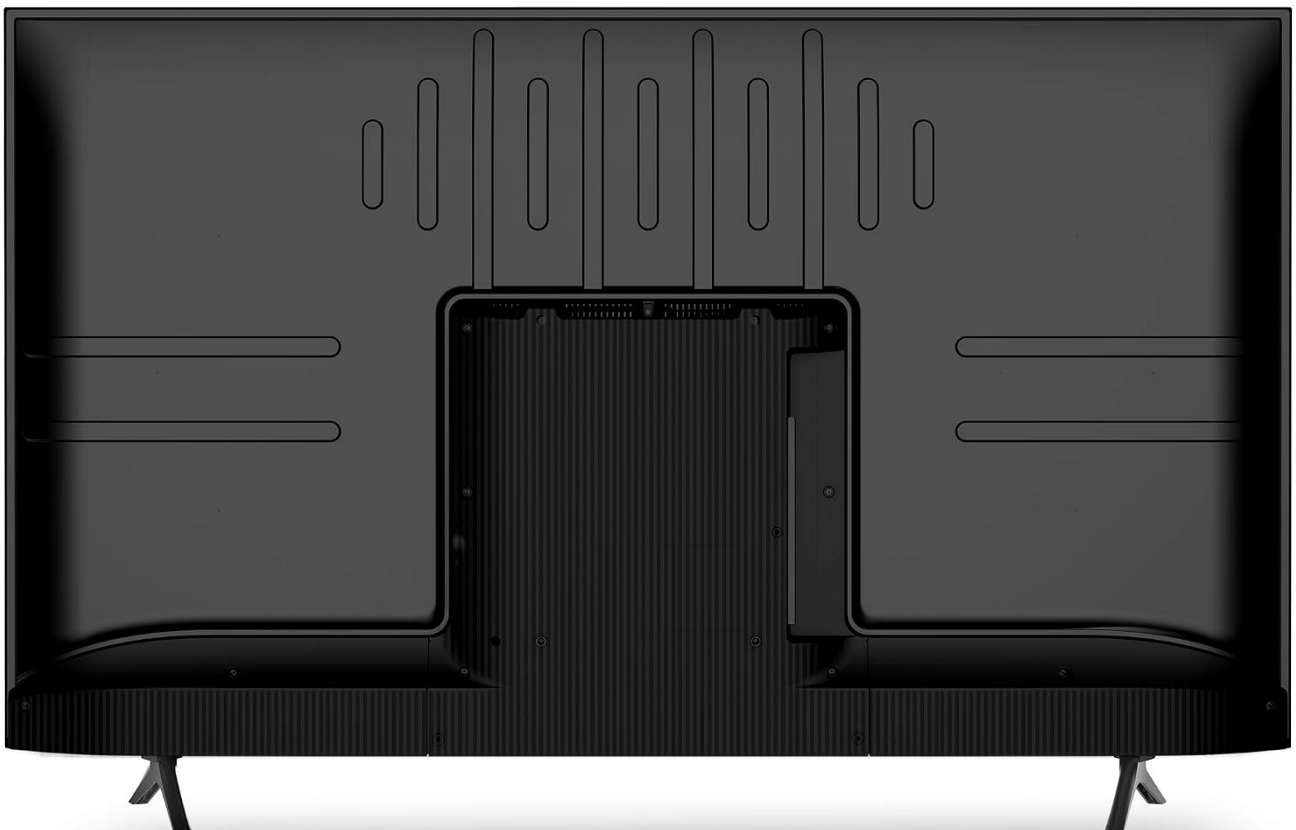

# Vu 126 cm (50 inches) 4K Ultra HD Smart Android LED TV 50UT User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

## 2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

## 3. SETUP

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### 3.1 Mounting the Television

Your Vu TV comes with options for both table-top placement and wall mounting. Choose the method that best suits your environment.

#### 3.1.1 Table Mount Installation

To install the table stand:

1. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, flat surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align the table stands with the screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stands using the provided screws.
4. Carefully lift the TV and place it on a stable, level surface.

### **3.1.2 Wall Mount Installation**

### 3.2 Connecting External Devices

Your TV offers various ports for connecting external devices such as set-top boxes, gaming consoles, Blu-ray players, and USB storage devices.

- **HDMI Ports:** Connect up to 3 HDMI devices for high-definition audio and video.
- **USB Ports:** Connect up to 2 USB devices for media playback or external storage.
- **Wi-Fi:** Connect to your home network wirelessly for internet access.
- **Bluetooth 5.0:** Connect wireless accessories like headphones or game controllers.
- **Optical Audio Out:** For connecting to external sound systems.
- **Ethernet (LAN):** For a wired internet connection.

3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, network connection, and Google account login.

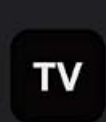
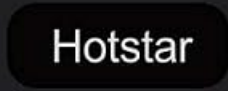
## 4. OPERATING THE TELEVISION

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### 4.1 Remote Control Functions

The ActiVoice Remote Control uses both IR and Bluetooth technology for versatile control. It features dedicated hotkeys for popular streaming services.

- **Power Button:** Turns the TV on or off.
- **Voice Assistant Button:** Activates Google Assistant for voice commands.
- **Navigation Pad:** Use to navigate menus and select options.
- **Back Button:** Returns to the previous screen.
- **Home Button:** Accesses the Android TV home screen.
- **Volume +/-:** Adjusts the volume level.
- **Channel +/-:** Changes TV channels.
- **Hotkeys:** Direct access to Netflix, YouTube, Prime Video, Hotstar, and Google Play.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning Your TV

- For stubborn marks on the screen, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a specialized screen cleaner (do not spray directly onto the screen).
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they can damage the finish.

### 5.2 Software Updates

Your Android TV may receive software updates periodically to improve performance and add new features. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive these updates. You can check for updates manually in the TV's settings menu.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common solutions:

| Problem                          | Possible Solution                                                                                                                                                         |
|----------------------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| No Power                         | Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and a working power outlet. Check if the power outlet is functioning.                                         |
| No Picture, but Sound is Present | Check the input source (HDMI, AV) to ensure it matches the connected device. Verify that the external device is powered on and functioning correctly.                     |
| No Sound, but Picture is Present | Check the TV's volume level and ensure it is not muted. Verify audio output settings if using external speakers.                                                          |
| Remote Control Not Working       | Replace the AAA batteries in the remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor. For Bluetooth remote, ensure it is paired correctly. |
| Cannot Connect to Wi-Fi          | Ensure your Wi-Fi router is on and working. Re-enter the Wi-Fi password carefully. Try restarting both the TV and your router.                                            |

| Picture Quality Issues<br>(e.g., blurry, distorted) | Check the resolution settings of the input source. Ensure the cables are securely connected. Try adjusting picture settings on the TV. |
