INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the VECELO 4 Corner Metal Canopy Bed Frame. This manual provides detailed instructions for assembly, usage, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure safe and proper operation of your new bed frame. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly and retain it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Keep all children and pets away during assembly. Small parts can be a choking hazard.
- Assemble the bed frame on a soft, non-abrasive surface (e.g., carpet or cardboard) to prevent scratches.
- Ensure all bolts and screws are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten all connections.
- Do not use power tools for assembly as this may overtighten and damage the frame.
- Do not stand or jump on the bed frame.
- Distribute weight evenly across the bed frame.
- Use only the mattress size specified for this frame (Queen).

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Headboard and Footboard sections
- Side Rails
- Canopy Posts (4)

- Canopy Top Rails
- Bed Slats / Support Bars
- Center Support Bar(s) and Legs
- Hardware Pack (bolts, washers, nuts, Allen wrench)
- Instruction Manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. It is recommended to have two people for assembly.

Step 1: Prepare the Area and Identify Parts

Unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface. Identify each part by comparing it to the diagrams in the included instruction manual. Ensure all hardware is present.

Step 2: Assemble Headboard and Footboard

Attach the decorative elements to the main headboard and footboard frames if they are separate pieces. Use the provided bolts and Allen wrench, but do not fully tighten yet.

Step 3: Connect Side Rails

Attach the side rails to the assembled headboard and footboard. Ensure the connection points are aligned. Secure with bolts, leaving them slightly loose for adjustments.

Step 4: Install Center Support System

Place the center support bar(s) and any associated legs into position. Secure them to the side rails or designated points on the frame. This provides crucial stability.

Step 5: Place Bed Slats

Lay the bed slats across the frame, ensuring they are evenly spaced and secured to the side rails. Some slats may click into place, while others may require screws. This forms the mattress foundation.

Step 6: Attach Canopy Posts and Top Rails

Insert the four canopy posts into the designated corners of the bed frame. Then, connect the canopy top rails to form the upper canopy structure. Secure all connections.

Step 7: Final Tightening

Once all parts are assembled, go back and fully tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten. Ensure the frame is stable and level.

OPERATING (USAGE)

Mattress Placement

Carefully place your Queen-sized mattress onto the assembled slat foundation. No box spring is needed with this platform bed frame.

Canopy Use

The four-post design allows for the addition of decorative canopy drapes or mosquito netting (not included). Ensure any fabric is securely attached and does not interfere with movement or pose a safety hazard.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically (every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain stability and prevent squeaking.
- **Weight Distribution:** Avoid concentrating heavy loads in one area of the bed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed frame is wobbly or unstable.	Loose bolts or uneven assembly.	Ensure all bolts are fully tightened. Check that the frame is assembled squarely and on a level surface.
Squeaking noises.	Loose connections, friction between metal parts, or uneven floor.	Re-tighten all bolts. Apply a small amount of lubricant (e.g., silicone spray) to connection points if squeaking persists. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
Missing parts.	Packaging error.	Contact VECELO customer support with your purchase details and a list of missing parts.
