
Improving your document management system

SETUP

1. Unpacking and Physical Placement

- Carefully remove the scanner and all accessories from the packaging.
- Place the scanner on a stable, flat surface with adequate space for document feeding and output.
- Extend the input and output trays as needed to accommodate documents.

2. Connecting the Scanner

- Connect the power adapter to the scanner and a power outlet.
- Connect the USB cable from the scanner to an available USB port on your computer.

3. Software Installation

- Insert the provided installation CD/DVD into your computer's drive, or download the latest drivers and software (including PaperStream IP) from the official Fujitsu support website.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the software installation. PaperStream IP is a TWAIN compliant driver that offers powerful image cleanup tools.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Loading Documents

- Open the document feeder cover and adjust the side guides to match the width of your documents.
- Load documents into the automatic document feeder (ADF). The scanner supports mixed paper sizes and weights, eliminating the need for pre-sorting.
- The ADF has a standard sheet capacity of 80 pages.
- The scanner also supports scanning of plastic and embossed cards.

2. Initiating a Scan

- Ensure the scanner is powered on (green light on the Power button).
- On your computer, open the scanning software (e.g., PaperStream Capture or other compatible application).
- Select your desired scanning profile or adjust settings such as color mode (color, grayscale, monochrome), resolution (up to 600 dpi optical), and output destination.

- Press the 'Scan/Stop' button on the scanner or initiate the scan from the software interface. The scanner operates at 40 pages per minute (ppm) and performs duplex scanning.

3. Utilizing Software Features

- PaperStream IP includes tools to remove colored and decorated backgrounds, automatically remove blank pages, and improve Optical Character Recognition (OCR) accuracy for searchable PDFs.
- Review scanned images within the software and make any necessary adjustments or corrections before saving.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning Procedures

- Regularly clean the scanner's rollers and glass surfaces to prevent dust and debris from affecting scan quality.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth lightly dampened with a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Avoid spraying cleaner directly onto the scanner.
- Refer to the detailed cleaning instructions in the full user manual for specific components.

2. Roller Replacement

- Over time, the feed rollers may wear out, leading to paper feeding issues.
- Consult the full user manual for instructions on how to inspect and replace the rollers. Replacement kits are available from authorized Fujitsu dealers.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Paper Jams:** If a paper jam occurs, carefully open the scanner covers and remove any jammed paper. Ensure documents are loaded correctly and the side guides are adjusted.
- **Poor Scan Quality:** Clean the scanner's glass and rollers. Ensure the original documents are clean and flat. Adjust scanning settings (e.g., resolution, brightness) in the software.
- **Scanner Not Detected:** Verify that the USB cable is securely connected to both the scanner and the computer. Check that the scanner's power is on. Reinstall the scanner drivers if necessary.
- **Software Errors:** Ensure your scanning software and drivers are up to date. Restart the software and/or your computer.
