

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Design and Display

The Innovator 16 boasts an industry-leading 9 mm profile, making it exceptionally thin and portable. Its 15.6-inch Full HD (1920x1080) display utilizes full-laminated technology, which seamlessly combines the glass and the screen to minimize parallax and enhance visual clarity. The display supports 92% Adobe RGB color gamut, providing a diverse and vibrant spectrum of colors for accurate artwork.



The Innovator Display 16 comes with a battery-free stylus that never needs charging, allowing for hours of uninterrupted drawing. The stylus supports up to 60 degrees of tilt action, helping you to create natural and seamless shading.





Image: Illustration demonstrating the stylus's 8192 pressure sensitivity levels and 60-degree tilt support.

3. SETUP & CONNECTIVITY

The Innovator 16 connects to your computer via a convenient 3-in-1 USB cable, simplifying cable management and setup.

Connecting the Device

Use the provided 3-in-1 cable to connect your Innovator 16 to your computer. This cable includes connections for HDMI (video signal), USB-A (data for pen input), and a separate USB-A for power. The power USB-A cable can be connected to your computer's USB port or an external power adapter (included).

Driver Installation

Before using your Innovator 16, you must install the latest driver from the official XPPen website. Ensure any existing tablet drivers from other brands are uninstalled before proceeding.

For Windows Users:

Download the Windows driver from the XPPen website. Close all drawing programs and run the driver installer as an administrator. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.

For Mac Users:

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Stylus

The battery-free stylus is your primary tool for interaction. It offers precise control with 8192 levels of pressure sensitivity and supports up to 60 degrees of tilt for natural shading. The stylus features two customizable buttons that can be configured for various functions, such as right-click or eraser mode.

Customizing Express Keys and Roller Wheels

The eight express keys and two roller wheels on the side of the display can be customized through the XPPen driver software. This allows you to assign frequently used shortcuts or functions from your preferred creative applications, enhancing your workflow efficiency.

Display Calibration

For optimal accuracy, calibrate your display through the driver software. This ensures that the cursor aligns perfectly with your pen tip on the screen.

5. Maintenance & Care

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your Innovator 16 Pen Display.

Cleaning the Display

Use the provided cleaning cloth to gently wipe the display surface. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the screen.

Pen Nib Replacement

The pen holder contains spare nibs and a nib removal tool. If your pen nib becomes worn, use the tool to carefully pull out the old nib and insert a new one.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Innovator 16, refer to the following common solutions:

- No Signal/Display Issues: Ensure all cables (HDMI, USB data, USB power) are securely connected. Try connecting the power USB-A cable to a wall adapter if using a laptop.
- Pen Not Working/Inaccurate: Verify that the latest driver is correctly installed. Recalibrate the display through the driver software. Check for any conflicting tablet drivers and uninstall them.
- Express Keys Not Responding: Open the driver software and ensure the keys are correctly mapped to your desired functions. Check if the application you are using is whitelisted in the driver settings.
- Driver Conflicts (Mac OS): For Mac OS Mojave or later, ensure
