Wosports Golf Rangefinder User Manual

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Wosports Golf Rangefinder is a versatile laser measurement device designed for both golf and hunting. It offers precise distance measurement, slope compensation, flag-lock with vibration, and speed/scan/angle measurement capabilities. Its compact and durable design ensures reliable performance in various outdoor conditions.

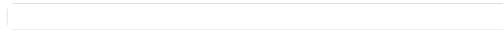


Image: Front-angle view of the Wosports Golf Rangefinder, showcasing its blue and black casing with the WOSPORTS logo.

Key Features:

- **650 Yards Range:** Accurate distance measurement up to 650 yards.
- **Flag-Lock with Vibration:** Quickly locks onto the flagstick with a short vibration to confirm target acquisition.
- **Slope Compensation:** Provides adjusted distances for uphill and downhill shots (can be turned off for tournament play).
- **Multiple Measurement Modes:** Includes Distance, Speed, Scan, and Angle measurement.
- **6x Magnification:** Clear and bright optics for easy target identification.
- **Innovative Battery Cover:** Integrated design prevents loss of the battery cover.

2. SETUP

Battery Installation:

The Wosports Golf Rangefinder comes with an innovative, inseparable battery cover design. To install or replace the battery:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the device.
2. Twist the integrated battery cover counter-clockwise to open. The cover will remain attached to the device.
3. Insert the included CR2 battery, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals are aligned correctly as indicated inside the compartment.
4. Twist the battery cover clockwise to securely close the compartment.

Note: The device uses one CR2 3V battery. Ensure the battery is inserted correctly to avoid damage to the unit.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Powering On/Off:

- To power on, press the **Power/Measure** button once. The display will activate.
- The device will automatically power off after approximately 8 seconds of inactivity to conserve battery.

Diopter Adjustment:

Rotate the eyepiece to adjust the focus until the display and target appear clear and sharp.

Switching Measurement Units (Meters/Yards):

In the powered-on state, **long press** the **Mode** button for more than 3 seconds to switch between Meters (M) and Yards (Y).

Mode Selection:

Press the **Mode** button briefly to cycle through the available measurement modes. The current mode will be indicated on the display.

A. Golf Mode (M2/M3 - Flagpole Lock with Vibration & Slope):

This mode is ideal for golf. It features flagpole lock technology and provides slope-adjusted distances.

- Aim the crosshairs at the flagstick or desired target.
- Press and hold the **Power/Measure** button.

- The device will scan and lock onto the nearest target (flagpole) within 180 yards, providing a short vibration and displaying the distance.
- The slope-adjusted distance will also be displayed (if slope function is enabled).

B. Hunting Mode (Fog & Speed):

Designed for hunting, this mode offers fog compensation and speed measurement.

- **Fog Mode:** Helps in conditions with light fog, providing more accurate readings.
- **Speed Mode:** Allows you to measure the speed of a moving object. Aim at the object and press the **Power/Measure** button. The speed will be displayed in km/h or mph.

C. Scan Mode:

For continuous measurement of multiple targets or moving objects.

- In Scan mode, press and hold the **Power/Measure** button.
- Pan the rangefinder across different targets. The distance readings will continuously update on the display.

4. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Lenses:

- Use the provided cleaning cloth or a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the lenses.
- Do not use abrasive materials or harsh chemicals, as they can damage the lens coatings.
- For stubborn spots, a small amount of lens cleaning fluid designed for optics can be used.

General Care and Storage:

- Store the rangefinder in its protective carrying case when not in use.
- Keep the device in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the device to severe impacts.
- If the device will not be used for an extended period, remove the battery to prevent leakage.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Device not powering on:**
 - Check if the battery is inserted correctly with the correct polarity.
 - Replace the battery with a new CR2 3V battery.
- **Inaccurate or inconsistent readings:**
 - Ensure the target is within the effective range (5-650 yards).
 - Clean the objective and eyepiece lenses with the provided cloth.
 - Ensure there are no obstructions between the rangefinder and the target.
 - Avoid measuring through glass or highly reflective surfaces.
 - Inquire about environmental conditions (heavy fog, rain) that might affect performance.
- **Display is dim or flickering:**

- The battery may be low. Replace it with a new one.
- **Flag-lock not working:**
 - Ensure the flagstick is within 180 yards for optimal flagpole locking.
 - Keep the rangefinder steady while scanning for the flag.
