1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Hisense 43H5500G Full HD Smart Android TV. The 43H5500G model features a Full HD 1080p display, integrated Android Operating System with Google Assistant, DTS Studio Sound for immersive audio, and built-in Bluetooth connectivity. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your television.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening the packaging, ensure all components are present and undamaged. The box should contain:

- Hisense 43H5500G TV
- Power Cable
- Remote Control
- TV Stand (Left and Right)
- Screws for TV Stand
- AAA Batteries for Remote Control
- Quick Start Guide and Warranty Card

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Unboxing and Initial Placement

It is recommended that two people handle the TV during unboxing and setup to prevent damage. Carefully remove the TV and all accessories from the packaging. Inspect the TV for any signs of damage before proceeding. If any damage is found, contact customer support immediately.

3.2 Attaching the TV Stand

1. Lay the TV face down on a soft, clean surface (like a blanket or foam) to protect the screen.
2. Identify the left ('L') and right ('R') stand feet.
3. Align each stand with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.
4. Secure each stand using the provided screws and a Phillips-head screwdriver. Ensure they are firmly attached.

3.3 Wall Mounting (Optional)

The TV is compatible with VESA wall mounts. Refer to your wall mount's instructions for proper installation. Mounting screws are not included with the TV.

3.4 Connecting Power

Plug the power cable into the TV's power input and then into a wall outlet. The power cable is pre-attached to the TV.

3.5 Initial Power On

Insert the included AAA batteries into the remote control. Press the power button on the remote to turn on the TV and begin the initial setup wizard for the Android TV operating system.

4. OPERATING YOUR TV

4.1 Remote Control Functions

Your Hisense TV comes with a voice remote control, featuring dedicated buttons for common functions and Google Assistant integration.

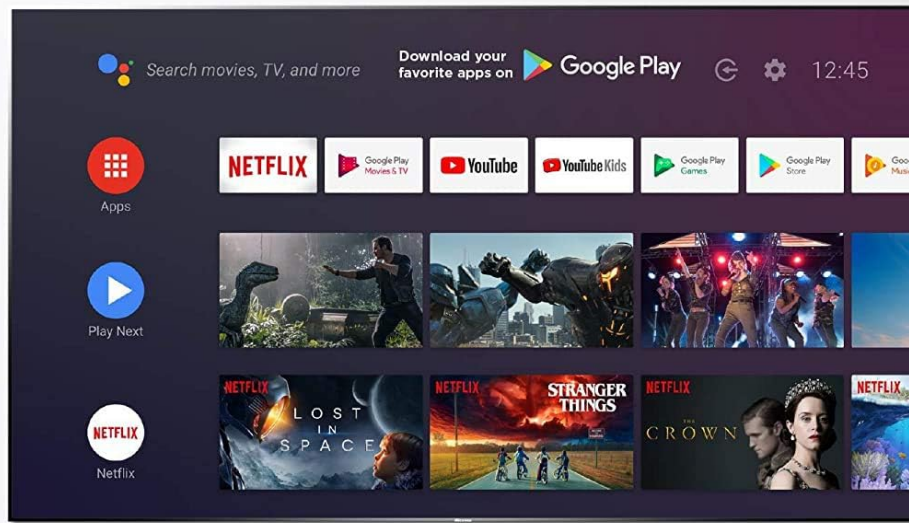
- **Power Button:** Turns the TV on or off.
- **Input Button:** Cycles through available input sources (HDMI, Composite, TV).
- **Volume Up/Down:** Adjusts the audio volume.
- **Channel Up/Down:** Changes TV channels.
- **Navigation Pad (Up/Down/Left/Right) and OK:** Used to navigate menus and select options.
- **Google Assistant Button:** Activates voice control for searching and controlling smart home devices.
- **App Shortcut Buttons:** Quick access to popular streaming services like Netflix, YouTube, and Google Play.

For optimal remote performance, ensure the remote is paired via Bluetooth to the TV. This can typically be done in the TV's settings under 'Remotes & Accessories'.

4.3 Inputs and Outputs

- 1 Ethernet port
- 2 USB Ports (v 2.0)
- 1 Digital Audio Output (Optical)
- 1 RCA Composite Video Input
- 1 L/R Audio Input for composite

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Hisense TV, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-specific cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Cleaning the Frame:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the TV frame and stand.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the TV's ventilation openings are not blocked to prevent overheating.
- **Power Cord:** Regularly check the power cord for any damage. If damaged, discontinue use and contact customer support.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Remote Control Lag:** If the remote is slow to respond, ensure it is properly paired via Bluetooth in the TV's settings. If not paired, the remote relies on an IR sensor which can be less responsive.
- **Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues:** The TV may primarily support 2.4GHz Wi-Fi networks. If you are having trouble connecting to a 5GHz network, try connecting to a 2.4GHz network instead.
- **General System Slowness:** The Android TV operating system can sometimes be resource-intensive. If the TV feels consistently slow, consider using external streaming devices (e.g., Chromecast, Roku) connected via HDMI for a potentially smoother experience.
- **No Power:** Check that the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the wall outlet. Try a different outlet if necessary.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, Composite) are secure.
- **Damaged Screen Upon Delivery:** Carefully inspect the TV screen immediately upon unboxing. If any damage is present, do not proceed with setup and contact the retailer or Hisense customer support for assistance.



