### INTRODUCTION

This rug is designed for indoor use and features a power-loomed, machine-made construction with a low pile and a rubber backing for durability and stability.

## SETUP AND PLACEMENT

---

Upon receiving your rug, follow these steps for initial setup:

1. **Unrolling:** Carefully unroll the rug in your desired location. Due to packaging, the rug may have temporary creases or curls.
2. **Flattening:** To help the rug lay flat, reverse roll it for a short period, or place heavy objects on the corners and edges for 24-48 hours. The rug will naturally flatten over time with regular use.
3. **Placement:** Position the rug in an indoor area, such as a living room, bedroom, or dining area. Ensure the floor surface is clean and dry before placement.
4. **Rug Pad (Optional but Recommended):** For added comfort, slip resistance, and to protect your flooring, consider using a non-slip rug pad underneath.

## OPERATING AND USAGE

---

Your Catalina Rug is designed for everyday indoor use. While it does not require "operation" in the traditional sense, understanding its characteristics will enhance your experience:

- **Traffic Areas:** This rug is suitable for various indoor traffic levels. Rotate the rug periodically to ensure even wear, especially in high-traffic areas.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged direct sunlight exposure, as this may cause colors to fade over time.
- **Furniture Placement:** When placing furniture on the rug, use furniture pads to prevent indentations and protect the rug fibers.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper maintenance will help preserve the beauty and extend the life of your rug. This rug is stain resistant and washable.

### Regular Cleaning:

- **Vacuuming:** Vacuum regularly (1-2 times per week) using a vacuum cleaner without a beater bar, or with the beater bar set to a high pile setting, to remove dirt and debris. Vacuum in different directions to pick up all loose particles.
- **Spot Cleaning:** For spills, blot immediately with a clean, dry cloth. Do not rub, as this can spread the stain. For stubborn stains, use a mild rug cleaner and follow the product instructions, testing on an inconspicuous area first.

### Deep Cleaning (Washable Feature):

As this rug is washable, follow these guidelines for deeper cleaning:

- **Machine Wash:** For smaller rugs, check your washing machine's capacity. Use cold water on a gentle cycle with a mild detergent.
- **Hand Wash:** For larger rugs or if machine washing is not feasible, hand wash with cold water and mild detergent.
- **Drying:** Air dry flat or hang to dry. Avoid direct heat or sunlight during drying. Ensure the rug is completely dry before placing it back on the floor to prevent mildew.

### General Tips:

- Trim loose fibers with scissors; do not pull them.
- Professional cleaning is recommended every 12-18 months for thorough maintenance.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter with your area rug:

| Problem                      | Possible Cause                                     | Solution   |
|------------------------------|--|--|
| Rug not lying flat / Creases | Due to packaging and shipping.                     | Reverse roll the rug, or place heavy objects on affected areas for 24-48 hours. Allow time for natural flattening. |
| Shedding                     | Normal for new rugs, especially machine-made ones. | Regular vacuuming will reduce shedding over time. This is not a defect.  |
| Fading colors                | Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight.             | Rotate the rug periodically. Consider using blinds or curtains to limit direct sunlight.                           |
| Rug slipping                 | No rug pad or worn-out backing.                    | Use a high-quality non-slip rug pad. Ensure the floor is clean and dry.  |
