INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your EP EXERCISE N PLAY City Police Station Building Blocks Set, Model A326. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly to ensure correct usage and to prevent potential issues. This set is designed for children aged 6 and up.

Safety Warning: Choking Hazard - Small Parts. Not for children under 3 years.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before starting assembly. The package should contain:

- 736 building block pieces for the City Police Station and vehicles.
- Instruction booklet for assembly.
- Components for a 3-level police command center.
- Components for scout towers, radar, and garages.
- Components for an escort car.
- Components for a prison van.
- Components for additional police vehicles.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included instruction booklet to assemble the City Police Station and its accompanying vehicles. Organize the building blocks by color and shape to facilitate the assembly process.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully open the packaging and lay out all building blocks. Refer to the parts list in the instruction booklet to ensure all pieces are present.

2. **Follow Booklet:** Begin assembly by following the numbered steps in the instruction booklet. Each step illustrates which pieces to connect and where.
3. **Connect Pieces:** Ensure pieces are firmly pressed together to create stable connections. If a piece does not fit easily, verify its orientation and ensure it is the correct piece for that step.
4. **Build Police Station:** Construct the 3-level police command center, including the prison gates, scout towers, radar, and police garages, as detailed in the instructions. The completed police station measures approximately 11.5 inches (30 cm) high, 10.3 inches (26 cm) long, and 5.2 inches (13 cm) wide.
5. **Assemble Vehicles:** Proceed to assemble the escort car, prison van, and other police vehicles according to their respective sections in the instruction booklet.
6. **Final Check:** Once assembly is complete, review the finished model to ensure all parts are correctly attached and the structure is stable.

This building block set is designed for imaginative play. Once assembled, the police station and vehicles can be used to create various scenarios.

- **Role-Playing:** Engage in role-playing as police officers, commanding the station and deploying vehicles for various missions.
- **Vehicle Movement:** The assembled vehicles are designed for manual movement. They do not require batteries or remote control.
- **Interactive Features:** Utilize features like opening prison gates and movable vehicle parts to enhance play.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity of your building block set.

- **Cleaning:** To clean the building blocks, gently wipe them with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the plastic.
- **Drying:** Ensure all pieces are completely dry before storing to prevent moisture damage.
- **Storage:** Store the assembled set or individual blocks in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. A storage container can help keep all pieces together.
- **Disassembly:** If disassembling the set for storage, do so carefully to avoid breaking or bending pieces.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues during assembly or play, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Missing Pieces:**

Thoroughly check all packaging materials, including bags and boxes, as small pieces can sometimes be overlooked. If pieces are still missing, contact customer support for assistance.
- **Pieces Not Fitting:**

Ensure you are using the correct pieces for the current step by cross-referencing with the instruction booklet. Verify the orientation of the pieces; some blocks may only fit in one specific direction. Apply firm, but not excessive, pressure to connect pieces.
- **Structure Instability:**

Review previous assembly steps to ensure all connections are secure. Loose connections can lead to an unstable structure. Re-press any loose blocks firmly into place.
- **Damaged Pieces:**

If any pieces are damaged upon opening the package, do not attempt to force them. Contact customer support for replacement parts.
