- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstruction.
- This appliance is intended for household use only.
- Children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge can use this appliance if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Electrolux LNT5MF36U0 is a TwinTech Total No Frost refrigerator designed to keep food fresh longer. It features MultiFlow technology for stable temperatures and a humidity-controlled drawer for optimal vegetable storage.

## 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

### 3.1 Unpacking

- Remove all packaging materials, including protective films and adhesive tapes.
- Check the appliance for any transport damage. Report any damage immediately to your retailer.

### 3.2 Placement

- Place the appliance on a firm, level surface. Use the adjustable feet to level the appliance if necessary.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance. Maintain a minimum distance of 10 cm from walls and other furniture to allow for proper air circulation.
- Avoid placing the appliance near heat sources (e.g., ovens, radiators, direct sunlight) or in excessively cold environments.

### 3.3 Electrical Connection

- Before plugging in, ensure the voltage and frequency on the rating plate match your household power supply.
- Connect the appliance to a properly earthed socket. Do not use extension cords or multiple adapters.
- Allow the appliance to stand upright for at least 4 hours before plugging it in to allow the refrigerant to settle.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 4.1 Control Panel

The appliance features Dual Touch electronic controls for easy temperature management of both the refrigerator and freezer compartments.

To adjust settings, simply touch the corresponding icons on the panel. Refer to the full manual for detailed instructions on specific functions like Fast Freeze or Holiday Mode.

## 4.2 Temperature Settings

- **TwinTech Total No Frost:** This technology ensures stable temperature and humidity levels in both compartments, preventing frost build-up and keeping food fresh longer.
- **MultiFlow:** Maintains a consistent temperature throughout the refrigerator compartment, preventing food from drying out and preserving its flavor.
- Use the electronic controls to set the desired temperature for the refrigerator (typically between 2°C and 8°C) and freezer (typically between -16°C and -24°C).

## 4.3 Humidity Control Drawer

The dedicated humidity-controlled drawer provides an optimal environment for storing fruits and vegetables, keeping them crisp and fresh.

- Adjust the humidity slider on the drawer to suit the contents. Close the vents for leafy greens and herbs to retain moisture. Open the vents for items that prefer less humidity.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

### 5.1 General Cleaning

- Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.
- Clean the interior with a soft cloth and a mild, non-abrasive detergent. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly.
- Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. For stainless steel surfaces, use a specialized cleaner.
- Regularly clean the door seals with warm water to ensure they remain flexible and seal properly.

### 5.2 Defrosting

This appliance features TwinTech Total No Frost technology, meaning manual defrosting is not required for either the refrigerator or freezer compartments. Any minor frost build-up will be automatically managed by the system.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Before contacting service, check the following common issues:

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |

| Problem                                  | Possible Cause  | Solution  |

| Appliance does not operate.              | No power supply.  | Check if the plug is correctly inserted into the socket. Check the fuse.                            |
| Temperature is too high.                 | Door not closed properly; large amount of warm food inserted; ambient temperature too high. | Ensure door is fully closed. Avoid placing hot food inside. Reduce ambient temperature if possible. |
| Excessive noise.                         | Appliance not level; objects touching the back wall.  | Adjust the leveling feet. Ensure nothing is touching the appliance's rear.                          |
| Water on the bottom of the refrigerator. | Drain hole blocked.   | Clean the drain hole at the back of the refrigerator compartment.                                   |




Image: The energy label for the Electrolux LNT5MF36U0, showing its energy class F, annual energy consumption of 313 kWh, and capacities.
