Swan Nordic Breakfast Set Instruction Manual

Models: Kettle, 2-Slice Toaster, 20L Microwave (Set Model: STRP1060WHTNEU)

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient use of your Swan Nordic Breakfast Set, which includes a 1.7L Kettle, a 2-Slice Toaster, and a 20L Digital Microwave. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain this manual for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Read all instructions before use.
- Do not immerse cords, plugs, or appliances in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Use only attachments recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not use outdoors.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

Kettle

1. Unpack the kettle and its base. Place the base on a flat, stable surface.
2. Before first use, fill the kettle with clean water to the maximum level. Boil the water and then discard it. Repeat this process two to three times to remove any manufacturing residues.
3. Ensure the lid is securely closed before boiling.

Toaster

1. Remove all packaging materials and labels from the toaster.
2. Ensure the crumb tray is correctly inserted at the bottom of the toaster.
3. For the first use, operate the toaster without bread on the highest setting to burn off any manufacturing residues. A slight odor or smoke may be present; this is normal.

Microwave

1. Remove all packing materials from inside and outside the microwave oven.
2. Install the turntable ring and glass tray inside the microwave cavity. Ensure they are properly seated.
3. Place the microwave on a flat, stable surface with adequate ventilation space around it.
4. Plug the microwave into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Kettle Operation

- **Filling:** Open the lid and fill the kettle with the desired amount of water. Do not fill below the minimum mark or above the maximum mark.
- **Boiling:** Place the kettle on its power base. Press the power switch down. The indicator light will illuminate, and the kettle will begin to heat.
- **Automatic Shut-off:** The kettle will automatically switch off once the water has boiled. The indicator light will extinguish.
- **Pouring:** Carefully lift the kettle from its base and pour the hot water.

Toaster Operation

- **Placing Bread:** Insert up to two slices of bread into the toasting slots.

- **Browning Control:** Select your desired browning level using the browning control dial (1 for light, 6 for dark).
- **Start Toasting:** Press the carriage lever down until it latches. The toaster will begin toasting, and the indicator light will illuminate.
- **Functions:**
 - **Reheat:** Press the "Reheat" button to warm previously toasted bread without further browning.
 - **Defrost:** Press the "Defrost" button to toast frozen bread. This function automatically adjusts toasting time.
 - **Cancel:** Press the "Cancel" button at any time to stop the toasting cycle.
- **Ejection:** Once toasting is complete, the bread will automatically pop up.

Microwave Operation

- **Setting the Clock:** When first plugged in, the display will show "0:00". Press "Defrost/Clock" once, then turn the "Time/Weight" knob to set the hour. Press "Defrost/Clock" again, then turn the knob to set the minutes. Press "Defrost/Clock" to confirm.

- **Microwave Cooking:**

- a. Place food in a microwave-safe container on the glass turntable.
- b. Close the microwave door securely.
- c. Press "Micro Power" repeatedly to select the desired power level (e.g., P100 for 100% power, P80 for 80% power).
- d. Turn the "Time/Weight" knob to set the cooking time.
- e. Press "Instant/Start" to begin cooking.

- **Defrost by Weight:**

- a. Place frozen food on the turntable.
- b. Press "Defrost/Clock" twice. The display will show "dEF1".
- c. Turn the "Time/Weight" knob to select the food weight (e.g., 200g to 2000g).
- d. Press "Instant/Start" to begin defrosting.

- **Express Cooking:** Press "Express" repeatedly to select quick cooking times (e.g., 30 seconds, 1 minute, 1 minute 30 seconds). Press "Instant/Start" to begin.

- **Pause/Cancel:** Press "Pause/Cancel" once to pause cooking, or twice to cancel the program.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

General Cleaning Tips

- Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- Wipe exterior surfaces with a damp cloth and mild detergent, then dry thoroughly.

Kettle Cleaning

- **Exterior:** Wipe with a damp cloth.
- **Interior/Descaling:** Over time, mineral deposits (limescale) may build up. To descale, fill the kettle with a mixture of equal parts water and white vinegar, or use a commercial descaling solution. Bring to a boil and let it stand for an hour (or as per descaler instructions). Empty and rinse thoroughly several times with fresh water.
- **Filter:** The removable anti-limescale filter can be rinsed under running water.

Toaster Cleaning

- **Crumb Tray:** Regularly slide out the crumb tray from the bottom of the toaster and empty crumbs. Wipe the tray with a damp cloth and dry before reinserting.
- **Exterior:** Wipe with a damp cloth. Do not use metal scouring pads.

Microwave Cleaning

- **Interior:** Wipe the inside of the oven with a damp cloth after each use. For stubborn stains, place a bowl of water with lemon juice inside and microwave for a few minutes to loosen food particles.
- **Turntable:** The glass turntable and turntable ring can be removed and washed in warm soapy water or in a dishwasher.
- **Door Seals:** Clean the door seals and adjacent parts carefully with a damp cloth to ensure proper sealing.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Kettle

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Kettle does not heat.	Not plugged in; power switch not pressed; dry boil protection activated.	Ensure kettle is plugged in and switch is on. If dry boil protection activated, allow to cool before refilling.
Water tastes metallic.	New appliance residue.	Perform initial cleaning steps (boil and discard water several times).

Toaster

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bread does not toast.	Not plugged in; carriage lever not fully depressed.	Ensure toaster is plugged in. Push carriage lever down until it latches.
Uneven toasting.	Crumb buildup; inconsistent bread thickness.	Empty crumb tray. Ensure bread slices are of uniform thickness.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Microwave does not start.	Door not closed properly; not plugged in; incorrect settings.	Ensure door is firmly closed. Check power connection. Verify cooking settings.
Food not heating evenly.	Food not stirred/rotated; turntable not rotating.	Stir or rearrange food during cooking. Check if turntable and ring are correctly placed and clean.

A troubleshooting solution is to clean and maintain the device which is based on page 6 of the manual. The defect could be due to needing to empty the crumbs tray, it is worth emptying after each use to prohibit a build up of crumbs which may affect the operation of the device. The customer has stated that the customer is holding down the lever for a period of 5 to 10 seconds, which should allow the lever to stay in place and connect correctly, this will provide a balance 'tossing' of the bread. Any heavy handling to the device may also cause damage to the lever and the handle, even small damages gradually become worse over time.

Our customer service team have stated that the placement of the central heating panel will generate higher heat than the outside heating panels. This is because there is a lot more heat generated from the combined gases resulting in the inner side of the toast being slightly crispier simply because the bread item will be exposed to a more concentrated amount of heat. Therefore, there may be a slight imbalance when toasting.
