1. Introduction

This manual provides instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your Panda PAN356HB 1.34 Cu.Ft. Portable Washing Machine. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Observe the following safety precautions to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury:

- Ensure the washing machine is connected to a grounded 110-volt power outlet.
- Do not operate the machine if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- Keep the area around the washing machine clear of flammable materials.
- Do not allow children to play on or in the appliance.
- Always unplug the machine before cleaning or performing maintenance.
- Do not wash items that are soiled with cooking oils, gasoline, or other flammable substances.
- Ensure the water inlet and drain hoses are securely connected to prevent leaks.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

- Capacity: 1.34 Cu.Ft. capacity, accommodating up to 10 lbs. of laundry.

- Program Options: 10 wash programs and 5 adjustable water levels.
- User-Friendly Controls: Easy-to-operate control panel with LED display.
- Safety Features: Child lock protection and auto unbalance detection.
- Portability: Equipped with two wheels at the back bottom for easier movement.

4. SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your portable washing machine:

4.1 Water Connection

1. Locate the inlet hose and quick adapter.




Image 4.1: Inlet hose with quick adapter. This image shows the white inlet hose with a metal quick adapter on one end and a plastic connector on the other.

2. Connect the plastic end of the inlet hose to the water inlet on the back of the washing machine.

3. Attach the quick adapter to a standard faucet. Ensure a tight connection to prevent leaks.

4. Adjust water temperature at the faucet as the machine has only one water inlet.

4.2 Drain Hose Setup

1. Position the drain hose to hang into a sink or wash basin.




Image 4.4: Drain hose positioned to hang into a sink. The corrugated grey drain hose is shown with its curved end hooked over the edge of a basin.

4.3 Power Connection

1. Plug the regular 3-prong power cord into a grounded 110V electrical outlet.

4.4 Moving the Machine

The machine is equipped with two wheels at the back bottom for easier movement.

To move, tilt the machine back at a 45-degree angle and roll it to the desired location.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Familiarize yourself with the control panel and follow these steps for operation:

5.1 Loading Laundry

- · Open the transparent lid.
- Load clothes into the stainless steel tub, ensuring not to exceed the 10 lbs. capacity.
- · Add appropriate detergent.
- · Close the lid securely.

5.2 Selecting a Wash Program

The machine offers 10 wash programs:

- 1. Press the 'Power' button to turn on the machine.
- 2. Press the 'Program' button repeatedly to cycle through the available programs (Normal, Quick Wash, Heavy Duty, Soak & Wash, Wash, Wash & Rinse, Rinse & Spin, Spin, Air Dry). The selected program

will be indicated on the LED display.

- 3. Adjust the water level by pressing the 'Water Level/Spin' button. There are 5 water levels (1/22L to 5/33L).
- 4. Press 'Start/Pause' to begin the wash cycle.

5.3 Delay Start Function

To use the delay start function:

- 1. Select your desired wash program and water level.
- 2. Press the 'Delay' button to set the delay time in hours.
- 3. Press 'Start/Pause'. The machine will start the cycle after the set delay time.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your washing machine.

6.1 Cleaning the Tub

- Periodically run a 'Tub Clean' cycle (if available) or a 'Normal' cycle with hot water and a washing machine cleaner.
- Wipe down the interior of the tub with a damp cloth after each use to prevent residue buildup.

6.2 Cleaning the Filter

- Locate the lint filter, typically inside the tub or near the top rim.
- Remove and clean the filter regularly to ensure efficient lint removal. Rinse under running water and reinsert.

6.3 Exterior Cleaning

• Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start	Power cord unplugged; Lid not closed; No water supply.	Check power connection; Ensure lid is fully closed; Check water inlet hose and faucet.
Water leakage	Loose hose connections; Damaged hose.	Tighten all hose connections; Inspect hoses for damage and replace if necessary.
Excessive vibration/noise	Uneven load; Machine not level.	Redistribute laundry evenly; Adjust leveling feet to ensure stability.
Clothes not spinning dry	Overloaded; Drain hose blocked.	Reduce load size; Check drain hose for kinks or blockages.
