SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of the GeneralAire GFX4 Digital Automatic Humidistat involves electrical wiring and connection to your HVAC system. It is strongly recommended that installation be performed by a qualified HVAC professional to ensure correct wiring, safe operation, and compliance with local electrical codes.

Key Installation Considerations:

4. **Fan Control:** The GFX4 includes a fan control feature that can keep the furnace blower running for a period after the humidifier shuts down, helping to distribute moisture evenly and prevent condensation in ducts.
5. **Display Backlight:** The LCD display features a backlight for visibility in various lighting conditions.

Refer to the specific wiring and operation diagrams included with your product for detailed button functions and advanced settings.

MAINTENANCE

The GeneralAire GFX4 Digital Automatic Humidistat requires minimal maintenance. Regular checks can help ensure its continued optimal performance.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe the exterior of the humidistat with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Sensor Check:** Ensure the outdoor sensor is free from obstructions and debris.
- **System Check:** During routine HVAC maintenance, have your professional installer verify the humidistat's connections and functionality.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your GeneralAire GFX4 humidistat, consider the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Display/No Power:** Check the power supply to the humidistat and the external transformer. Ensure all wiring connections are secure.
- **Incorrect Humidity Reading:** Verify that the outdoor sensor is properly installed and not obstructed. Ensure the humidistat is not located near a direct heat or cold source that could affect its readings.
- **Humidifier Not Activating:** Confirm the desired humidity setpoint is higher than the current room humidity. Check the humidifier unit itself for power and operational status. Ensure the furnace blower is functioning.
- **Humidifier Running Constantly:** Check the desired humidity setpoint. If the outdoor temperature is very low, the humidistat may limit the maximum indoor humidity to prevent condensation.

For persistent issues or complex problems, it is recommended to contact a qualified HVAC technician or GeneralAire customer support.
