2. PACKAGE CONTENTS AND SETUP

2.2 Initial Charging

The device comes with a built-in rechargeable Lithium Polymer battery. For optimal performance, fully charge the recorder before first use.

1. Connect the voice recorder to a computer's USB port or a USB wall adapter (not included) using the provided USB cable.
2. The device's screen will indicate charging status.
3. A full charge typically takes approximately 2-3 hours.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Basic Recording

The Vandlion voice recorder features a simple one-key operation for recording.

1. To start recording, slide the power switch to the "ON/REC" position. The device will begin recording after approximately 5 seconds.
2. To save the recording and stop, slide the power switch to the "OFF/SAVE" position.

3. Each recording is automatically named with a timestamp, making file organization straightforward.

3.2 Voice Operated Recording (VOR)

The VOR feature allows the recorder to automatically start recording when sound is detected and pause when silence occurs, conserving battery life and memory space.

- This feature is ideal for capturing only relevant audio, reducing unnecessary gaps in your recordings.

3.3 Playback

You can play back recordings directly from the device using the provided headphones.

1. Connect the headphones to the recorder's audio jack.
2. Use the playback controls on the headphone cable to navigate through files, adjust volume, and play/pause.

3.4 File Management

- **Connecting to a Smartphone (OTG):** With an OTG adapter (included), you can connect the recorder directly to compatible Android smartphones to manage files on the go.

4. MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life of your Vandlion voice recorder.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the device. Avoid using liquid cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the recorder in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To maintain battery health, avoid fully discharging the device frequently. If storing for an extended period, charge it to about 50% every few months.
- **Software:** Periodically check the manufacturer's website for any firmware updates that may improve performance or add features.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your voice recorder, please refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Low battery; device frozen.	Charge the device for at least 30 minutes. If still unresponsive, try resetting by holding the power button for 10-15 seconds.
Poor recording quality / White noise.	Microphone obstructed; recording in a noisy environment; incorrect VOR sensitivity.	Ensure microphone is clear. Record in a quieter environment. Adjust VOR sensitivity settings. Ensure the device is not rattling against keys or other objects during recording.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cannot connect to computer / Files not visible.	Faulty USB cable; incorrect connection; driver issue.	Try a different USB port or cable. Ensure the device is properly connected and recognized as a removable disk. Restart your computer.
Recordings cut out or device disconnects during playback.	Loose connection; low battery; file corruption.	Ensure the USB cable is securely connected. Charge the device fully. If files are corrupted, try re-recording.
Device memory full.	Too many recordings stored.	Transfer important files to a computer and delete unnecessary recordings from the device.
