

1. Introduction

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

3.1 Assembling the Stand and Pedals

The DEP-20 Digital Piano comes with a furniture stand and a 3-pedal unit for a complete piano experience. Follow the instructions provided in the separate assembly guide for detailed steps on putting together the stand and attaching the pedal unit. Ensure all screws are securely tightened for stability.



The 3-pedal unit (soft, sustain, sostenuto) is designed for easy assembly and provides full expressive control.

3.2 Connecting Power and Audio

- 1. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN port on the rear panel of the piano and then to a power outlet.
- 2. For private practice, connect headphones to one of the two 6.35mm headphone jacks on the front panel.
- 3. To connect to external amplification or recording devices, use the Audio Out ports.
- 4. The USB MIDI port allows connection to a computer for MIDI data transfer.

The rear panel offers multiple connectivity options for various devices.


4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Functions

- Power On/Off: Press the Power button located on the control panel to turn the piano on or off.
- Volume Control: Use the master volume knob to adjust the overall sound level.
- **Tone Selection:** Use the dedicated buttons or navigate through the menu on the LCD screen to select from 238 available tones.
- Metronome: Activate the metronome function to assist with timing and rhythm practice.

Connect headphones to the outputs for silent practice day or night, either solo or alongside your piano teacher.




Practice silently using headphones connected to one of the two headphone jacks.

- **Dual-Tone Mode:** Press the Dual-Tone button to layer two different instrument sounds. Adjust their volumes independently for desired balance.
- **Recording:** The piano supports MIDI recording. Refer to the detailed instructions in the full manual for recording and playback procedures.
- MP3 Playback: Connect a USB drive with MP3 files to the MP3 interface to play along with your favorite

songs.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the piano. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the piano in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Handling:** Always lift the piano by its base when moving it. Avoid placing heavy objects on the keyboard or applying excessive force to the keys.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound	Power not connected, volume too low, headphones connected.	Check power connection, increase volume, unplug headphones.
Keys not responding	Power issue, internal malfunction.	Restart the piano. If issue persists, contact support.
Distorted sound	Volume too high, faulty cable, external interference.	Lower volume, check cables, move away from other electronics.
Pedals not working	Pedal unit not properly connected.	Ensure pedal cable is fully inserted into the correct port.
