Beldray Multi Steam Pro Garment Steamer User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Beldray Multi Steam Pro Garment Steamer. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always ensure the voltage indicated on the product matches your mains supply voltage.
- Do not immerse the steamer, power cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Unplug from the mains supply when not in use and before cleaning.
- Use only distilled or de-mineralized water to prevent mineral buildup.
- Do not touch the hot steam head during operation.
- Always hold the steamer upright during use.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

- Main Steamer Unit
- Removable Water Tank (260 ml capacity)
- 2-in-1 Soft and Lint Brush Attachment
- Mini Measuring Cup
- Power Cord (1.9 m)

SETUP

- 1. Fill the Water Tank:** Remove the 260 ml water tank from the main unit. Use the provided mini measuring cup to fill the tank with distilled or de-mineralized water. Do not overfill.

2. **Attach Water Tank:** Securely re-insert the filled water tank into the steamer unit until it clicks into place.
3. **Attach Brush (Optional):** For deeper steam penetration and lint removal, attach the 2-in-1 soft and lint brush to the steamer head.
4. **Plug In:** Plug the power cord into a suitable mains power outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Heat Up:** Once plugged in, the steamer will begin to heat up. This takes approximately 45-50 seconds. The indicator light will change or turn off when ready.
2. **Steam Garments:** Hold the steamer upright. Press and hold the steam trigger to release steam. For continuous steam, engage the lockable steam trigger.

3. Steaming Technique:

- Hang the garment on a hanger.
- Hold the fabric taut with one hand.
- Move the steamer head slowly over the fabric, from top to bottom.
- For stubborn creases, use the brush attachment to open the fabric fibers.

4. **Continuous Steam:** The steamer provides 12-15 minutes of continuous steam on a full tank.
5. **Refilling:** If the water tank runs dry, unplug the steamer and allow it to cool before refilling.

MAINTENANCE

1. **Cleaning:** Always unplug the steamer and allow it to cool completely before cleaning. Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
2. **Descaling:** To prevent mineral buildup, especially if using tap water (though distilled water is recommended), descale the steamer regularly.
 - Mix a solution of 50% white vinegar and 50% water.
 - Fill the water tank with this solution.
 - Run the steamer until the tank is empty.
 - Repeat with clean distilled water to rinse.
3. **Storage:** Ensure the steamer is completely cool and dry before storing. Store in a cool, dry place. The compact design

allows for easy storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or weak steam	Water tank empty; Steamer not heated sufficiently; Mineral buildup.	Refill water tank; Allow full heat-up time (45-50 seconds); Descale the steamer.
Water leaking from steam head	Overfilled water tank; Steamer not fully heated; Condensation buildup.	Do not overfill; Allow full heat-up time; Hold steamer upright.
Steamer not turning on	Not plugged in; Power outlet fault.	Ensure plug is fully inserted; Try a different power outlet.




