1986 Topps Garbage Pail Kids Series 6 #240B Eve Droppin' Card Guide

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This guide provides detailed information regarding the 1986 Topps Garbage Pail Kids (GPK) Series 6 collectible card, specifically card number 240B, featuring the character "Eve Droppin'". Garbage Pail Kids are a series of sticker trading cards produced by Topps, known for their satirical and gross-out humor, parodying the popular Cabbage Patch Kids dolls.

- **Card Number:** The card number "240B" is typically located on the top left or right corner of the card front.
- **Character Name:** The character name "Eve Droppin'" is prominently displayed on the card front, usually within a distinct banner or design element.
- **Artwork:** The artwork for card 240B depicts a character with exaggerated ears, suggesting the act of eavesdropping. The specific details of the illustration are unique to this card.
- **Series:** This card belongs to the 6th series of Garbage Pail Kids, identifiable by the overall design and numbering scheme of that series.

3. CONDITION ASSESSMENT

The condition of a collectible card significantly impacts its value. When assessing the condition of your "Eve Droppin'" card, consider the following factors:

- **Corners:** Examine all four corners for any signs of wear, such as rounding, fraying, or creasing. Sharp corners indicate better condition.
- **Edges:** Check the edges for nicks, dings, or whitening. Smooth, clean edges are desirable.
- **Surface:** Look for scratches, indentations, print defects, or loss of gloss on both the front and back surfaces.
- **Centering:** Evaluate how evenly the image is centered within the card borders. Poor centering can reduce the card's appeal.
- **Creases/Bends:** Any creases or bends, even minor ones, will significantly lower the card's grade.

Common grading scales for collectible cards include Near Mint (NM), Excellent (EX), Very Good (VG), and Good (G), with variations in between. This specific card is described as "EX or Better," indicating it should be in excellent condition or higher.

4. STORAGE AND CARE

Proper storage is crucial for preserving the condition and value of your collectible card. Follow these guidelines:

- **Protective Sleeves:** Always store the card in a soft, acid-free penny sleeve to prevent surface scratches.
- **Toploaders or Card Savers:** For added rigidity and protection, place the sleeved card into a rigid toploader or a semi-rigid card saver.
- **Storage Boxes:** Store cards upright in dedicated cardboard storage boxes or plastic cases designed for trading cards.
- **Environment:** Keep cards away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. A cool, dry, and dark environment is ideal.
- **Handling:** Always handle cards by their edges to avoid transferring oils from your skin or causing surface damage.



